



At UVM, Archie earned eight laiters: two for prose country, four for beskeiball, and two in track. He graduated from UVM in 1927, and was president of his cleas for 60 years, reeigning in 1987. His two daughters and a granddaughtar graduated from UVM, which made Archie very proud.

He received his Ed.M. from UVM in 1941, and retired as associate professor emoritus in 1969, alter 40 years of service as coach of cross country and 'track. He served as director of physical education from 1942 to 1962.

For 40 years, Archia's philosophy of coaching was institled in his athletes. "A taacher of physical education falls in his job as an educator if his sole and driving aim is to increase the skills of his piayers that he and his team must win. The first and foremost aim of avory teacher or coach must be to make his boys and girls better men and woman."

At the time of his retirement, he was living in Jericho, VI., where he was a past town auditor: He was an active participant in the activtiles of the Second Congregational Church of Jericho, at various times serving as deacon and on various church committees.

He was a member of the Vermont Board of Approved Basketball Officials for 20 years and was a past president. He was selected by the Vermont Headmasters Executive Committee to serve as the state director of baskstball tournaments. He established and dirooted the annual Vermont High School Indoor Invitational Track and Relay Meet.

Among Arohie's many honors and scoomplishments were his election, in 1337, to Sigma Delta Pal, the national honorary athlatio fratemily, of which he was elected to the board of directors.

He became active in the community, joining the West Parish Congregational Church in Bethel, Purity Chapter, OES, Sportsman of Maine, and, most recenty, was a member of Bethel Aliance Lodge 97, F&AM, in Maine. He had joined Burlington Lodge 100, F&AM, in 1832 and received his 60-year pin in 1992.

He is survived by his wite. 


