PHIPPSBURG — Shirley E. Pratt, 75, a mechanic and former town selectman who ran a restaurant at Popham Beach, died Friday at Mid-Coast Hospital in Bath.

Mr. Pratt retired in 1977 after 30 years as a mechanic for New England Telephone Co. He serviced and repaired company trucks out of the telephone company garages in Bath and Brunswick.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

He served on the Phippsburg Board of Selectmen for about eight years during the 1970s.

Mr. Pratt and his wife, Anna Perkins Pratt, owned and operated Ocean View Park, a summer restaurant with a few cottages on Popham Beach.

They ran the popular seafood eat-in and take-out restaurant for 22 years before it was washed away during a heavy storm several

years ago. "People traveled for miles around to get their lobster rolls and fried clams," said Mr. Pratt's daughter, Gloria Barnes.

Throughout his retirement Mr. Pratt operated a small engine sales and service business out of his home workshop. He repaired mostly lawn mowers and snow throwers.

Born in Bath, he was a son of E. Melvin and Mary Banks Pratt. He attended Bath schools and later received a general equivalency diploma.

"He was a self-taught man," said his daughter. "After getting his GED he went on to school to become an assessor. That was while he was a selectman."

"He loved politics," said his daughter, adding that he was active with the town's Republican Committee and once ran unsuccessfully for the state Legislature.

"He did some campaigning for me a few years ago, and enjoyed every minute of it," said Barnes, who is Sagadahoc County Treasurer. "He was such a big fan, and he was so supportive. He did everything he could to encourage us to be the best we could."

Mr. Pratt played the drums in the Bath Area Senior Citizen Band. As a young man, he played in some small local dance bands.

He enjoyed boating and was a former secretary-treasurer of the Downeast Yacht Club, Boothbay Harbor.

A lifelong resident of the Bath and Phippsburg area, he lived for over 50 years in the Winnegance Section.

He was a 50-year member of Solar Lodge of Masons and was active in other Masonic organizations. He was a corporator of the Bath Savings Institution from 1978 to 1991, a member of the Telephone Pioneers, the Bodwell Grange and the Corliss Street Baptist Church.

Surviving are his wife of 54 years, a son, David M., and a daughter, Gloria Barnes, all of Phippsburg; a brother, Foster M., of West Bath; a sister, Beulah P. Dunton of Lisbon Falls; five grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

CALE ELIZABETH Sylvester Mason Pratt, 65, of Ivie Road died Tuesday in Portland.

Born in Oxford in 1907, he went from a one-room schoolhouse at Pratts' Corner to become a senior banking official at Casco Bank & Trust Co., where he served for 27 years.

He rose from assistant treasurer in 1945 to executive vice president and a director in 1963. When he retired in 1972, he was senior vice president and second in command at Casco. After retiring he continued to serve as an honorary director of the bank.

Known to many as "Syl," he was credited with starting the mortgage loan department at Casco Bank.

According to a column by Press Herald writer Bill Caldwell on restaurateur Donald Valle, Valle credits Pratt as "the man who lent him his first 'grub steak.' ... He risked the bank's money by lending the young Donald Valle \$500 to help buy 10 new bar stools after a fire destroyed his bar."

Pratt graduated from Hebron Academy in 1926 and graduated from the University of Maine at Orono, where he was a member of the varsity baseball team, in 1930. He played infield in the semi-pro Pine Tree League in the 1920s.

He was married to the former Margaret Ann Merrill from Old Town for more than 53 years until her death in 1985.

He attended Rutger's Graduate School of Banking and New England School of Banking at Williams College, which he helped create. In 1982, he received the Edward R. Tufts Achievement Award for his work organizing the New England

School of Banking at Williams.

He was a civic and business leader in Greater Portland and Maine and president of the trustees of Hebron Academy, where he remained an honorary trustee. He was a member of the Trustees of the Diocesan Funds of the Episcopal Diocese of Maine and a lifelong communicant, former vestryman and treasurer of St. Alban's Episcopal Church in Cape Elizabeth. He also served as a director of the Southern Maine Area Agency on Aging. For many years, he served as treasurer of the Maine Automobile Association where he continued as a director. He was a member of the Beta Theta Pi fraternity.

He was the second most senior member of the Woodfords Club. He helped organize the first Little League baseball team in Greater Portland called Fathers and Sons. He was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of the Portland Country Club and of the Cumberland Club.

He is survived by his son, S. Mason Pratt Jr. of Portland; his daughter-in-law, Carol C. Pratt; three grandsons, Benjamin G. of Salt Lake City, Utah, Stephan M. and Edward W., both of Portland, and three nieces, Dorothy Pratt Clark of Oxford, Muriel Pratt Fuller of Lovell, and Jeanette Pratt Roderick of Oxford.

A service will be held at 10 a.m. Friday at St. Alban's Episcopal Church, Shore Road. Burial will be at 2 p.m. Friday at Merrill Hill Cemetery, North Norway. Arrangements by Hobbs Funeral Home, South Portland.

Funeral services will be at 2 p. m. Friday at the Chestnut Street Methodist Church for Thomas Hollis Pratt, 82, who died Wednesday morning at 65 State Street after two weeks' illness with pneumonia.

Mr. Pratt was born at Bath Sept. 30, 1856, son of Thomas Hollis and Sarah Whitney Pratt. He attended the Bath common schools and high school there and came to Portland as a young man and entered the employ of the Eastern Steamship Company. He became purser on the Portland-Boston passenger boat and later was employed in the office of the company.

He became connected with the Chase Transfer Company in 1899, acquired an interest in that firm and became its manager and continued in that position 32 years until his retirement in 1931.

Mr. Pratt was a baseball player and

engaged in boxing as a young man and for more than 50 years had made many hunting and fishing trips to various sections of Maine and the White Mountains. He was for many years a member of the Davy Crockett Club, a sportsmen's organization in the Moosehead Lake region, and had served as guide and companion to hunting and fishing parties. He also was an expert checker player.

Mr. Fratt had been a member of the Chestnut Street Church since 1902 and was a member of the official board and the Sunday School and a life member of Deering Lodge of Masons.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Maud Pearson Pratt; one daughter, Mrs. Marion F. Davis of Portland; a sister, Mrs. Sarah J. Andrews of Portland; two brothers, George and Alfred Pratt of Bath; two granddaughters, Mrs. Ruth Leland of Fall River, Mass., and Mrs. Esther Webster of New York, and one great granddaughter, Nancy Leland.

The senior Past Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Maine, died quietly at his home in New Brighton, Staten Island, New York, Saturday, October 21st, at the age of 92 years, 6 months and 6 days. He was initiated in Ancient Land-Mark Lodge, October 24, 1854, at the age of 35. He became a charter member of Atlantic Lodge in 1855, and was the last survivor of the charter members. He was Grand Master in 1863-'64-'65, following Josiah H. Drummond, was Grand King of the Grand Chapter in 1864, Grand P. C. of Work in the Grand Council in 1859, and Deputy Grand Commander of the Grand Commandery in 1869.

In the Scottish Rite he was prominent very early, and was one of the 57 of the United Supreme Council in 1867 of whom only three survived at the September meeting in Saratoga, and by the recent deaths of Gen. Lawrence and Bro. Preble, only one is now left, Bro. Abram T. Metcalf, of Michigan. Bro. Preble had a considerable masonic library which he gave to the Portland Masonic Library.

He was a son of William Pitt Preble, who was an Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of Maine from 1820 to 1828, and married a daughter of John Mussey, whom he succeeded as Clerk of the U. S. District Court.

His home was opposite the head of Park Street, and he had a summer cottage at Great Diamond Island and afterwards at Pumpkin Nob, for many years.

Bro. Preble was born in Portland in the Churchill House, corner of State and Danforth Streets, April 15, 1819. His father was the great-great-grandson of the original ancestor in America, Abraham Preble, who came from England about 1636.

Commodore Preble was a third cousin of the Judge.

Bro. Preble's body was brought to Portland October 25th, was received by his brother 33ds, headed by Dr. Wm. C. Mason of Bangor, Deputy for Maine, and escorted to Evergreen Cemetery, where it was buried.
