



William Rexford Prosser

PORTLAND N William Rexford Prosser left this world with dignity Wednesday night, Nov. 30, 2005.

This past weekend he said with his characteristic chuckle, The Lord wonOt take me and the Devil doesnOt want me.

The attending physician said of Bill at his passing, We tried to bring him back; but he just seemed to not have the will to go on.

Bill defined the American dream. Born second to last in a dirt poor family of nine in the northern New Hampshire mill town of Groveton; and losing his father to a mill accident at are five left him with a legacy of tenacious self reliance.

He said of his growing up, We (kids) had to fight for food and a place in the bed in the unheated attic. On a cold night you could see the frost on the tips of the nails that stuck down through the roof.

At about age 14, Bill walked from Groveton, N.H., to Westbrook to open a new chapter in his life. He found work and a place to stay with George GrahamÖs family on Brook Road. Here he worked as a farm hand to earn his room and board. His dream, to attend Maine Agricultural College after finishing Westbrook High School, was shattered by the depression, and the premature death of his surrogate mother, Mrs. Graham.

Always one to make the best of a bad situation he, like most of his brothers, found work in the then bustling mills of upstate New York. This gangling and extremely shy farm boy named Rekky (from his middle name Rexford) soon became Bill, a popular and urbane-foreman at the plant. In spite of the sudden comforts of his new life (he could now afford a car) he stayed solidly connected to his Maine roots and to his sweetheart. Esther.

The bubble was soon to burst again as World War II broke out; and of course Bill, like most red blooded American boys, enlisted. Clearly he was now a leader of his peers and soon was promoted to staff sergeant as a technical instructor.

Never shy about reaching out for the golden ring Bill made one of the best moves of his life about this time, by marrying his longtime sweetheart and the love of his life, Esther Libby. They were together until her death in 1997.

After the war Bill returned home to Maine and worked with Esther to make themselves a good life. He built houses and renovated rental property. Along the way they developed a passion for antiques.

Again in 1969 fate struck Bill another hard blow. Heavily in debt rebuilding dilapidated rental property and with a son in college he suffered a heart attack. Lemons to anyone else are cherries to Bill. Again he about-faced, sold the rental property, a source of stress in his life, and devoted the rest of his working life to his and EstherÖs mutual love, collecting, buying and selling antiques.

In his later years he became an icon in the antique scene, mentoring many of this generationÔs antique professionals. Beyond work he was a dedicated member at Trinity Episcopal Church, Odd Fellow, Mason, bridge and billiard player at the WoodfordÔS Club as well as finding the time to be a fixture in Falmouth town politics. Bill, we all will miss you.

Mr. Proudfoot served in the U.S. Navy during World War II.


He was employed for 32 years with the former Lukens Steel Co. in Coatesville, Pa. until his retirement in 1970.


