Lincolntown, May 17—Funeral services for Granville A. Prock, widely-known retired Maine schoolmaster, who died at his home here Friday after an illness of several weeks, will be conducted at the home Sunday at 2 p. m., the Rev. Duncan Rogers of Lincolntown and the Rev. William Osgood of Islesboro officiating. A special trip of the ferryboat from Islesboro at 1 o'clock will bring many friends from the island to attend the rites.

Mr. Prock was born in the house in which he died, and following his graduation from Castine Normal School, he studied at Kent's Hill and Westbrook Seminary, later attending Bates College, where he received his degrees of A. B. in 1907.

For 10 years before his retirement in 1936, he had been principal of Islesboro High School and previously had been teacher at the grammar school in that town. In the interim of his two periods of service on the island he taught at Westbrook Seminary and Lubec and Kennebunkport High Schools. In all these places he distinguished himself by his sound scholarship and in his interest in all the agencies for the benefit of the younger people, particularly the church and the Boy Scouts, whose program he had headed at Kennebunkport. He was a member of King David Lodge of Masons of Lincolntown and of Eastern Lodge of Odd Fellows at Lubec.

Surviving are his widow, Lillian Greenlaw Prock, and several cousins.

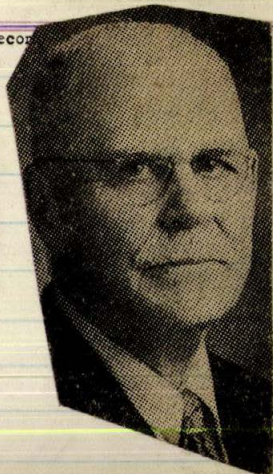

OAKLAND — Edward F. Pullen, 67, Oakland fire chief for 25 years, died Saturday morning at a Waterville hospital following a short illness. He was born in Oakland, Dec. 22, 1917, son of George and Helen Crowell Pullen.

He was employed by the U.S. Postal Department for 33 years and retired in 1973. He was a member of the Oakland Fire Department for 40 years, serving as a chief for 25 years.



He worked his way up through the ranks of the department, joining Hose Co. No. 2 in 1939, three years after he graduated from Williams High School. While serving in the U.S. Navy in World War II, he received specialized training in fire-control technology.

He was made chief in 1955 and retired in 1978. The 1978 Oakland Town Report, dedicated to Mr. Pullen, credited him for leading the department to "a position of efficiency and excellence." Mr. Pullen received a mounted fire bell at an appreciation supper honoring his retirement.

During his tenure as chief, Mr. Pullen oversaw the development of emergency medical services in Oakland. In 1964 he accepted the town's first rescue van, "The Cub," as a gift from the Oakland Lions. In 1978, he put the present, better-equipped rescue truck into service.

While he was chief, the department added a ladder truck and two pumpers to the fleet. He also oversaw the transition in communications from a "red phone" and call-box system to all-radio dispatching.

He earned the respect of the de-

partment and the community as well as fire personnel throughout the state, according to Assistant Fire Chief Ralph Farnham Sr. "He donated the best years of his life to the fire department," Farnham said.

Mr. Pullen was also an accomplished carpenter and cabinet maker.

He was past president of the Maine State Fire Chief Association and was a former Maine Fire School instructor. He was a member of the Decker-Simmons Post American Legion of Oakland.

He was past master of the Messalonskee Lodge 113, Ancient, Free and Accepted Masons; a 32nd degree Mason; member of the Scottish Rites; member, past high priest and current treasurer of the Drummond Chapter Royal Arch Masons; and member and treasurer of the Mount Lebanon Council, Royal and Select Masons. He was a past patron of the Order of the Eastern Star.

Mr. Pullen was a member of the Oakland-Sidney United Methodist Church and the Double and One Club of the church. He was a lifelong resident of this community and was a former member of the Oakland Town Council.

Surviving are his wife, Dorothy Hutchinson Pullen, of Oakland; two sons, Charles and Allen Pullen, both of Oakland; two brothers, George Pullen of Smithfield and Horace Pullen of Oakland; seven grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be today at 10 a.m. at the Oakland-Sidney United Methodist Church. Arrangements are by the Wheeler Funeral Home, Church Street, Oakland.
