Kenneth A. Prouty Sr., 86, of 17 Partridge Road, founder of the Portland Taxpayers Association, died Friday at a Portland hospital.

Mr. Prouty, who served as the association's first president until he stepped down at age 79, organized the group to protest escalating Portland taxes. The association has evolved into Portland's largest organized government watchdog group, and its members regularly monitor City Council spending practices.

"We've all seen taxes go up and up and up every year," he told the Evening Express in 1983. "We plan to do some research into every aspect of city government and if possible get government working on a business-like basis. We'll do just about anything we can to get the tax rate down."

Mr. Prouty added he had a strong interest in local government for years and decided it was time to get involved.

"I know so many people are hurting," he said.

"An awful lot of people who have businesses and nice homes are thinking about selling their homes and moving out of town because of taxes."

Mr. Prouty was a member of the Woodfords Congregational Church and sponsored Boy Scout activities in the church. He also served as representative to the Pine Tree Council, Boy Scouts of America.

He was a member of the Baskohegan Lodge of Masons in Danforth, the Scottish Rites Bodies of

Portland, and Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston. He was a former member of the Kora Shrine clubs of Portland and Auburn-Lewiston, the Gorham Country Club, the Portland Rotary Club and Woodfords Club of Portland.

Surviving are a son, Kenneth A. Jr. of Boxford, Mass.; and two grandsons.

His wife, Freda Weaver, died in 1989.
