Orren H. Randell, 76, retired motorman of the local street car service, and a resident of Greater Portland nearly 40 years, died suddenly Tues-

day afternoon in his home, 277 Broadway, South Portland.

Mr. Randell was born at Columbia, Washington County, Dec. 12, 1868, and received his schooling at Harrington, where he spent his boyhood. Following his marriage there in 1891, he and his wife resided at Millbridge and then at Nashua, N. H., before coming to Portland.

He entered the employ of the Portland Railroad Company in 1907 after a brief period with the Boston & Maine and Maine Central Railroads, and was continuously employed by the electric railway system until he was retired in 1934 by the former Cumberland County Power & Light Company, now the Central Maine Power Company.

He was a 32nd degree Mason, joining Narraguagus Lodge, No. 88, 54 years ago, and was also a member of Portland Commandery, Knights Templar, among other branches of the order, and of the Eastern Star. He was a member of Hadattah Lodge, IOOF, of Portland, first joining former Border Lodge at Calais, and afterwards affiliating with the Portland lodge.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. May Randall; a son, Harry A. Randall of Pittsburgh, Pa., and a granddaughter, Constance Jackson, Randall of South Portland.

Lewiston, Aug. 11. (AP)—Dr. R. N. Randall, well known Lewiston physician who was active in Central Maine horse racing and boxing interests, died from a heart ailment today. He was 75.

Doctor Randall, who was examiner for boxing cards here, had been ill for some time. He leaves a widow, a son, Warren, formerly of the staff of the Bangor Commercial, and a daughter, Miss Esther Randall.

He received his education at Kents Hill Seminary and Wesleyan University in 1904, and his medical degree from Boston University Medical School in 1906. Dr. Randall served his internship at the Trull Hospital, Biddeford, and came to Lewiston in 1910.

FALMOUTH - Thomas A. Randall, 67, the longtime owner of Town Landing Market who was active in community affairs, died Thursday at his home on Route 88. He was the husband of Muriel Cummings Randall.

In August 1952, Mr. Randall bought Town Landing Market on Falmouth Foreside, and for the next 29 years he worked long hours at running the popular neighborhood store. He was well known for his storytelling and for his sense of humor.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

"Tom created an environment somewhere between a well-run circus, a club and a restaurant," wrote former Evening Express columnist Kim Clifford on his retirement in 1981. Clifford worked in the store as a teen-ager. "It was always entertaining," she said.

Mr. Randall organized Halloween parties at the store for 20 years, and during the gasoline shortage in 1974 he made grocery deliveries in a horse and antique wagon. For many years, he had a sign advertising "Fresh Native Ice Cubes."

"He created that sign as a way of marketing his new ice cube machine," said his son, Stephen T. Randall. "It was back when ice cube machines were a novelty."



Mr. Randall organized Halloween parties at the store for 20 years, and during the gasoline shortage in 1974 he made grocery deliveries in a horse and antique wagon. For many years, he had a sign advertising "Fresh Native Ice Cubes."

"People would come in and say 'What are fresh native ice cubes?'" said his wife, Muriel. "He'd go into a long story about how he tried importing them, and how the shrinkage was so bad."

"Dad had a way of making everybody feel comfortable and I think they always left with a smile," said his son. "A lot of them came just to see Dad."

During his retirement, Mr. Randall worked with artists and galleries, transporting works of art between Maine and New York City.

Mr. Randall served on the Falmouth Zoning Board, Charter Commission and Landfill Committee and was chairman of the P.T.A. He was a Cub Scout Master for Pack 36.

He was a past president of the Falmouth Lions Club and in 1971 he was honored as the Lions' Citizen of the Year. He was also a member of the Falmouth Fire & Rescue.

Born in Sanford, one of 10 children of Elwyn H. and Hilda Moss Randall, he graduated in 1947 from Sanford High School. As a young man he sang with the Merry-men of Springvale, and he served in the Air Force from 1948-52.

Active in the Masons, he was a member of Casco Lodge in Yarmouth, the Scottish Rite Bodies, Valley of Portland, Maine Consistory. He was a former member of the Portland Commandery, an active member of Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston, and an officer and member of many other Shrine clubs and Masonic groups.

Surviving are his wife of 42 years of Falmouth, a son, Stephen T. of Portland, five daughters, Susan R. Maloney of Cumberland, Kathleen R. Marquis of Kennebunkport, Rebecca R. DeWever of Casco, Shirley R. Morneau of Scarborough and Audrey C. Randall of Concord, N.H., four brothers, Norman E. of Wells, R. Clifford of Shapleigh, Robert D. of Merrimac, Mass., and Kenneth M. of Jupiter, Fla.; five sisters, N. Jean Goodwin of Boynton Beach, Fla., Rita M. Foss of Falmouth, Shirley R. Schmottlach of Durham, Conn., Hilda Sorvart of Belding, Mich., and Linda Randall of Okinawa, Japan, and nine grandchildren.

One Man's Story

Thomas Cummings Randall II

Tom died on March 1 at 10:15 in the evening. He died as he had lived quietly and at peace. The time in the hospital (Memorial Hospital in North Conway) was short, just a few days and certainly if he had been given a choice this would have been the one.

Tommy, as he was then called, grew up in Freeport, Maine. His heritage was of Clipper Ships and with two Captains for grandfathers the sea was a big part of his young life. One of his treasures was a painting of the John A. Briggs. It was a clipper built in South Freeport at the Soule Slip Yard owned by his paternal grandfather, Captain Julius Soule and it sailed to China with the Randall family (wife and children) aboard and with Captain Rufus Randall at the helm.

Tom was orphaned at age 13. With no siblings he would have been totally alone had it not been for Randall aunts and Soule aunts who helped to steer his course. At 14 years of age he went to Mount Herman School for Boys founded by Dwight L. Moody, a Methodist evangelist. The school was in Northwestern Massachusetts. He was happy there and remained there for three years. Leaving (after graduating) he then went to Norwich Military Academy, a Cadet school in northern Vermont. At the end of his third year our nation was into the II World War. His class was asked to enlist as a group and they would be kept together. The class members all enlisted with the exception of one young man who was ill.

The war years were busy years for Tom. A tank commander, the Cavalry having been disbanded, he was placed with the 16th Cavalry Unit which was mechanized (tanks). He spent two years in Europe with General Patton's forces. Living was hard. Tom was never again to eat dark bread. The peasants made it with hay or straw and sometimes when the food kitchen did not, or could not, keep up with the units, they lived off the land. Tom's only injury was the loss of his middle finger on his left hand due to a gunpowder infection.

While at Fort Williams (an island off of Boston harbor) waiting for discharge he was accepted at Boston University Law School and was to spend two years there.

After Tom and I were married we returned to Maine and he attended Portland University Law School, he also lectured on two subjects, Torts and Contracts. He graduated with an LLB (Bachelor of Laws and Letters) and when Portland University Law joined the University of Maine he was awarded a J.D. (Doctor of Jurisprudence). Tom became a member of the Maine Bar and the American Bar Association in January of the next year.

Tom was busy and happy in his young married life. Myles Laing Randall (called Randy) came into our family in 1954 and Helen Elizabeth Randall in 1956. Two beautiful healthy little

Tom had become a Mason in Freeport with His Uncle Jack's help. (Uncle Jack was named John Briggs Randall as he was born on that ship.) Eventually at a young age Tom became a 32nd degree Mason. Years later he was to become quite active at the Scottish Rite Temple in Tampa, Florida. He then joined the Egypt Temple Shrine. He enjoyed the fellowship of the Brothers.

Music and the church took Tom's attention and time. He was a fine second tenor and when he lost his sight he mourned the loss of his music.

Tom and Randy were to be great pals, fishing, camping and hiking became a big part of their lives. We were to spend nine summers at Crystal Lake in Harrison, Maine. Betsy was daddy's little girl and was learning Latin phrases at two years of age (phrases attorneys use). Tom was so sure she was a genius. She was a bright and happy little girl.

Tom became ill in his late 40's. He was advised to leave his work and go to a warmer, easier climate. He had worked very hard at his career. When these young lawyers returned to Maine after the War was over they became active Democrats and the Democratic party was revived in Maine. One of his mentors was Edmund Muskie (later to become Secretary of State) in the President's Cabinet. He was to work under Ed Muskie in the OPS as price attorney but after a year and a Republican Administration the office was abolished. Tom had an office on Middle Street in Portland with a friend Caspar Trevanian and later joined judge Charles Pomeroy and attorney Milton Wheeler in their law office. Judge Pomeroy was the Adjudicator for bankruptcy. Eventually Tom went with Allstate Ins. Co. as House Counselor and in charge of personal injury cases for the State of Maine.

When Tom became ill in his late 40's he retired from Allstate after 17 years and moved with his family to Tampa, Florida. Tom again worked with Torts and Personal Injuries but for a hospital.

In 1992 Tom and I moved back to Maine. Daughter, Betsy was there with her two young children Ryan Dorothy and James Randall Ballard. Beautiful little grandchildren.

Tom had not been well, diabetes, 2 heart attacks, 5 bypasses and worst of all blinded by muscular degeneration, life was difficult. He had a fine mind and continued to vote, to keep track of news, local, national and international. I read the newspapers to him every evening. He had a warm loving family. Having no family of his own, nine became his. My sisters Dorasthea Somero, Pauline Locke and Barbara Brackett as well as two brother-in-laws, Edward Locke and William Brackett. There were also nieces and nephews, John and Peter Somero, Linda Somero Kinela, Charles Locke and Tom's namesake Thomas Locke, Steven, Bruce and Scott Brackett. Two more grandchildren, Gabrielle Elizabeth Druz and Christopher Thomas Randall (Randy's son and another namesake).

Tom died as he had lived without a whimper.

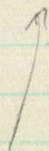

Mr. Ranger retired from his accounting firm in 1982, ending a career in which he enjoyed helping clients with taxes and bookkeeping, his son said.

He was born in New Vineyard, a son of John and Loey Mosher Ranger, attended one-room schools and graduated from Farmington High School in 1937. Mr. Ranger enlisted in the Navy in 1944 and served on the USS Douglas A. Murrow until 1946.

He was then a member of the American Institute and the Maine Society of CPAs. He was also a member of Central Square Baptist Church, the Woodfords Club, Korra Shrine, the Sixty Plus Club, Presumpscot Masonic Lodge and the Scottish Rite Bodies.
