Born in Rockland Jan. 29, 1940, he was a son of Vernon and Jean Demeter Raye. He was a 1958 graduate of Rockland High School. During his senior year, he enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps' deferred program and in July of that year entered boot camp training. He served in Okinawa until 1962, and for the last three months of active duty in Cuba. He continued his service with the Marine Corps Reserve.

Returning to civilian life, he

County authorities tonight were investigating the death of Ernest J. Record, 75, South Paris grocer, whose body was found this afternoon on a bed in his home.

While no bruises or marks were found on the body and Mr. Record, who lived alone, was known to have been suffering from heart disease, investigators were puzzled by the fact that a front door of the Record home was wide open and that an examination of the house failed to reveal any trace of a sum of money which Mr. Record may have had when he returned to his home Saturday night.

Mr. Record's death was discovered this afternoon when Mrs. Lillian Woodworth of Auburn, a family friend, went to the house to visit him. She obtained no response to her knock at the rear door, the one normally used by Mr. Record, and went to a nearby filling station and called James Mason, clerk in the Record store.

Mr. Mason was not at home but his father, Philip Mason, returned to the Record house with Mrs. Woodworth, succeeded in opening the rear door and found the body.

Deputy Sheriffs Cortland Hunt and Homer Farnham were called to investigate and were joined later by Sheriff F. F. Francis and Dr. D. M. Stewart, medical examiner.

Record was fully clothed except for his overcoat and suit coat which were found on the bed. There was no evidence of disorder in the house, authorities said.

Friends said Mr. Record usually carried the proceeds of the Saturday afternoon business in his store with him when he went home Saturday night but it was not known definitely whether he had done this last week. Several years ago Mr. Record and

his wife, who died two years ago, were attacked as they went into their home. Mr. Record was beaten but Mrs. Record saved several hundred dollars by passing the assailants a pocketbook containing only a small sum of money and hiding a bag containing the larger sum.
