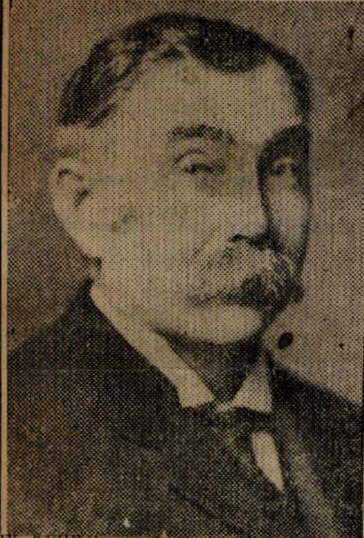

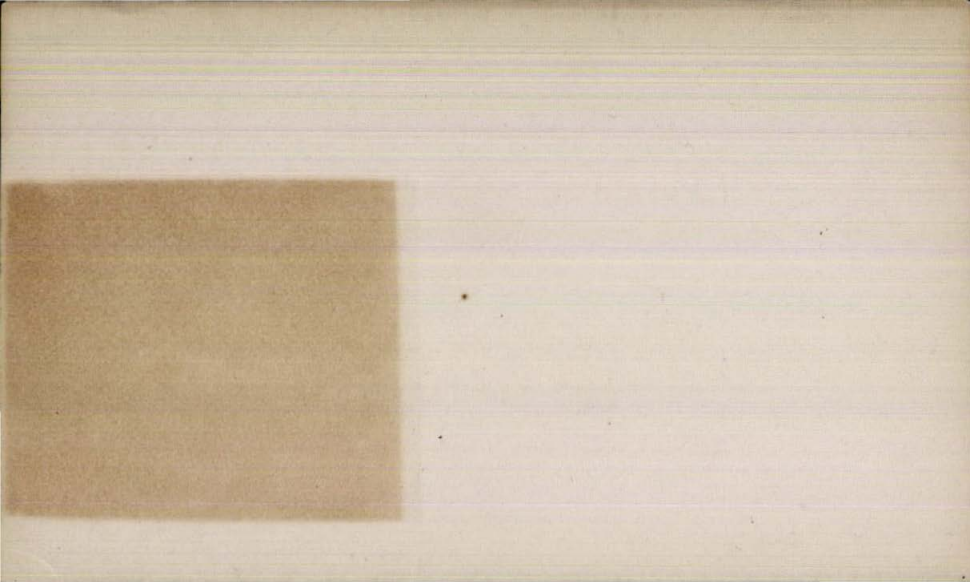

## W. Clifton Reeves

### Retired teacher and gunsmith

WINDHAM — W. Clifton Reeves, 94, a longtime industrial arts teacher and gunsmith, died Wednesday at a local nursing home after a long illness.

Mr. Reeves taught for 28 years in Falmouth, retiring in 1970. He started at the high school when it was still at the Plummer-Motz complex on Middle Road. When the high

school moved to Woodville Road, he stayed at Plummer-Motz to teach industrial arts to the junior high students.

After his retirement, he turned his lifelong hobby as a gunsmith into a business. He had a shop adjacent to his home on Gray Road, where he specialized in repairing guns and building custom stocks. He got all of his business through word of mouth, said his son, Roger C. Reeves.

"It was a natural thing, the wood and metal work, because he was an industrial arts teacher. He could do almost anything." In addition to gunsmithing, Mr. Reeves did cabinet work and built furniture, mostly for family, but also for pay, said his son.

Born in Portland, a son of Walter and Katherine Tuttle Reeves, he attended Portland schools. He moved to Windham in 1919, and graduated from Windham High School in 1923. He attended Springfield College for a year, where he played on the baseball team, but while he was home in Maine that summer, he broke his leg in a motorcycle accident. He never returned to Springfield,

but several years later he decided to return to college, and graduated in 1931 from Gorham Normal School. With the Great Depression on, he was one of only three in his graduating class to obtain a teaching position, as an industrial arts teacher at Bridgewater (Mass.) Junior High School. He kept that job for 11 years before returning to Windham and taking a job in Falmouth.

Mr. Reeves was a sportsman who enjoyed spending time at his log cabin on South Brook in Washington County, 12 miles outside the village of Grand Lake Stream. He had owned the camp since 1953.

He shot a lot of deer in Washington County and also in Argyle Township, said his son, including a couple of bucks back in the 1920s that weighed more than 200 pounds.

"We made a lot of trips to the Allagash back in the 1950s and 1960s," said his son. In 1958, they canoed the entire length of the Allagash Wilderness Waterway in six days.

Mr. Reeves was a member of the Maine Education Assoc., the Maine Retired Teachers Assoc. and the Cumberland County Retired Teachers. He was also a member of the Windham Friends Meeting, the Presumpscot Masonic Lodge, the Windham High School Alumni Assoc., the Windham Historical Society and a life member of both the National Rifle Assoc. and the Sportsman's Alliance of Maine.

Surviving are his wife of 71 years, Julia Rogers Reeves of Windham; a daughter, Betty Reeves Davis of Ft. Myers, Fla., and Gray; a son, Roger Clifton Reeves of Windham; a sister, Kathryn Forbes of Windham; four grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren.

There are no visiting hours. A funeral service will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday at Friends Meetinghouse, Gray Road. Burial will follow in Friends Cemetery. Arrangements are by Dolby Funeral Chapel, South Windham.
