AUGUSTA — Richard E. Reed, 84, of 34 Fairview Ave. died Dec. 30, 1989 at the Maine Veterans Home following a long illness.

He was born in West Tremont on Aug. 6, 1905, the son of Benjamin B. and Sylvia (Sprague) Reed. Mr. Reed graduated from Rockland High School and attended Coburn Classical Institute.

After attending school, he entered the newspaper field, working as a reporter for the Portland papers, Boston Post, the Batavia (N.Y.) News, the Miami Herald, the Associated Press and Buenos Aires Herald, Argentina. In 1928-29 he shipped out as a seaman.

Prior to his state government service, he was one of Maine's pioneer aerial photographers and was active in the public relations, newspaper and advertising fields throughout the state.

Mr. Reed was prominent in state government affairs for many years, having served as commissioner of the Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries (now Marine Resources) from 1946-51, a top publicity and public relations official with the old Maine Development Commission 1937-41, and director of the Maine Sardine Council from its inception by the Legislature in 1951 until his retirement in 1977.

While serving in these positions, he was active in many statewide, national and international organizations and traveled widely throughout the U.S. and many foreign countries. He build up the Department of Fisheries from a little-known agency to one of full service and importance to the state and to industry, and promoted Maine sardines and the production of them to national and worldwide recognition through the council.

Mr. Reed was a member of the Augusta Country Club and Masonic Lodge.

He is survived by his wife, Dorothy (Watts) Reed of Augusta; two sons, Richard E. Reed Jr. of Marblehead, Mass., and Bradford Reed of Framingham, Mass.; and one daughter, Deborah Hazeil of Marblehead, Mass.; one brother, Carl Reed of Owls Head; two grandchildren, and several nieces, nephews and cousins.

There will be no visiting hours. A graveside service will be held in the spring at Maine Veterans Memorial Cemetery.

WEEKS MILLS - Robert Wilbur Reed, 85, died Saturday at his home.

He was born in China, the son of Buford A. and Ethel E. (Taylor) Reed. He was educated in local schools and was a 1928 graduate of Erskine Academy in South China. He later attended the University of Maine in Orono.

On Oct. 5, 1935, he married Marcia A. Hisler in Larone.

From 1939 until 1971, Mr. Reed resided in Portland. He was employed with the Railway Mail Service from 1937 until 1960. When passenger train service in the area ended, he transferred to the Portland Post Office, retiring in 1971 as data systems management officer.

While in Portland, he was a member of Woodfords Congregational Church, the Portland Mount Sinai chapter, the Royal Arch Masons, the Portland branch of the Railway Mail Association, the Deering Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star and was a life member of the Deering Lodge of Masons. He served as cubmaster and scoutmaster of the Boy Scouts for over 10 years.

In 1971, he and his wife moved to China.

Mr. Reed was a past master of the Windsor Grange and a member of both the East Pomona and the Maine State Grange. He was clerk and treasurer of the Capitol Island Association and Capitol Island Village Corporation of Southport for 40 years. He was director and overseer for 20 years. He was manager and treasurer of the Middle Beach Group in Southport.

He was a secretary for the Dirigo Lodge of Masons in Weeks Mills and was past worthy patron and treasurer of Lily of the Valley Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star in Weeks Mills. He was active in the Erskine Academy Alumni Association, serving as its first secretary. He was active in the Weeks Mills, Dyer Hill and Chadwick Hill Cemetery Associations.

Mr. Reed was past president of the South China Public Library Association and past president and treasurer of the South China Community Fellowship Church Corporation. He was secretary and treasurer of the Weeks Mills Water Association, and past commander of the Theodore Roosevelt Camp of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War of South China.

He was formerly a director of the China Historical Society and secretary of the Weeks Mills Youth Center and Community House Corporation. He was active in the Windsor Grange Bowling League and the Dirigo Men's Club.

Surviving are his wife of Weeks Mills; his son W.R. (Bill) Reed of Lovettsville, Va.; his sister, Gladys Sproul of South China; several nieces and nephews.

A funeral service will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at Gray and Pratt Funeral Home, Windsor Neck Road, Windsor. The Rev. Winifred Reynolds will officiate. Burial will follow in Chadwick Hill Cemetery.

FORT FAIRFIELD — Walter M. Reed Jr., 74, died unexpectedly while playing golf at Aroostook Valley Country Club, Aug. 21, 1997. A champion golfer and well-known Aroostook businessman, Reed was born in Fort Fairfield, Dec. 18, 1922, the son of Walter M. and Eva (Seeley) Reed. He graduated from Fort Fairfield High School and attended the University of Maine, leaving during his senior year to enlist in the U.S. Army during World War II, where he served as a lieutenant in the South Pacific Theater. Upon discharge from the service, he joined the family potato business of Walter M. Reed and Sons, later to be known as Reed Farms Inc., of which he was president. He also served with distinction as president of Maine Potato Growers, Inc. for 22 years. Active in community and county affairs, Reed was a town counselor, a past chairman of the board and member of United Parish Church, Fort Fairfield Community Hospital, The Aroostook Medical Center, Maine Public Service Co., Northern National Bank, Casco Northern Bank, Foundation of the University of Maine at Presque Isle, Northern Maine Fair, Aroostook Raceway, Frontier Heritage Historical Society, and VFW Post 6187. Well-known in golfing circles throughout Maine and New Brunswick, Reed was Maine's Junior Golf Champion for two years as a young teen and, at 17, broke the course record at Aroostook Valley Country Club with 4 under par. At 18, while in college, he won the intercollegiate title twice representing the University of Maine, which honored him in 1996 with induction into its Sports Hall of Fame. He was an active member of the M Club. He also



achieved Maine Golt Hall of Fame status last year in Portland. In 1951, he was rated the No. 9 amateur golfer in Canada and that year was a member of the Willingdon Cup Team ranking fourth low amateur in individual competition. In 1952, he was Maine Open Amateur champion and medalist. He garnered twenty Aroostook Valley Country Club championships as well as five St. John Valley championships and three New Brunswick-Prince Edward Island Amateur Championships. He received an honorary doctorate degree from the University of Maine at Presque Isle. Reed owned and bred harness race horses for most of his life and was a fan of all University of Maine sports teams. Surviving are his wife, Dolly (Lamoreau) Reed, whom he married July 31, 1943; a son and daughter-in-law, Walter M. Reed III and Marcia; a daughter and son-in-law, Rayle and Edward E. Ainsworth of Yarmouth; four grandchildren, Elizabeth and Webster Reed and Alexa and Charles Ainsworth; one brother and sister-in-law, John and Cora Reed of Washington, D.C.; one sister and brother-in-law, Ruth and Arthur Mraz of Fort Fairfield. A memorial service will be held at 1 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 26, 1997, at the United Parish Church, Church Street, Fort Fairfield, with the Rev. Dr. Michael Stotts officiating. Family plans call for a memorial fountain to be placed in Reed's memory on Main Street in Fort Fairfield, the town he loved. 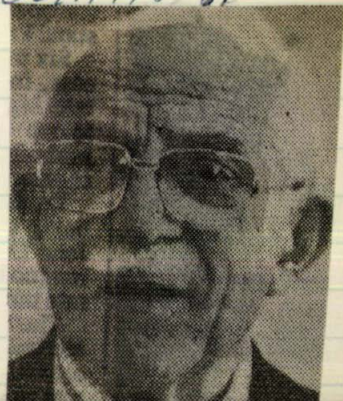
