

He was born Jan. 1, 1919 in Lynn, Mass., a son of Walter Manwell and Maybelle Beckwith Ricker.

Walter lived his entire life at the family home in Pittston. He was educated in Pittston and Gardiner schools and attained his bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Maine.

Having lost his dad and grandfather at a very early age, Walter went to work while still in high school to support his grandmother and siblings. He worked first at a filling station, then at S.D. Warren and finally at Bath Iron Works.

Walter was a veteran of World War II, serving honorably with the 535th AAB, from 1943 to 1945. He saw action in the European Theater, Normandy, France, the Rhineland, and Ardennes, Battle of the Bulge and Central Europe. Walter was awarded five battle stars and the Oak Leaf Cluster for the Normandy landing. He received the Belgium Fourragea for action at Elsonborn Crest and against the Slegfried line. Aside from the Normandy invasion and the Liberation of Paris, one of his most memorable experiences was defending and crossing the Ramagan Bridge just prior to the Germans blowing it up. Recently, two foreign medals were presented to the 535th unit members: they were the French a les Liberators metal and the Belgium commemorative medal.

When he returned from the service, he married his wife of 58 years, Lillian E. Whitten, and they had a daughter, Patricia Lee.

Walter was a quiet, dignified man who was respected by all who knew him. He was very loyal to his faith, his family and his country. He went to work for Central Maine Power Co., in 1946, working 35 years before retiring. He then joined the Old Timers Club in 1980. Walter was active in creating the C.M.P. Credit Union. He became a director in 1955, served on the board for 18 years and was its president from 1970 to 1973.

Walter was a Kennebec County deputy sheriff, from 1964 to 1980. He was a life member of the Veterans of Foreign War Post 9 of Gardiner, a 50-year member of the Herman Masonic Lodge 32 of Gardiner, and a member of the Scottish Rites Bodies of Augusta, the Consistory of Portland, and the Kora Shriners of Lewiston. He was very pleased with a trophy he was presented for support of the Shriners Children Hospital.

As a lover of animals, Walter was a life member of the Kennebec Valley animal shelter. As a young man, Walter was very active in town affairs. He served as chairman of the building commission for the new Pittston school under the newly formed SAD 11. He served on the board of directors for 10 years and as chairman from 1968 to 1969. He also served on the Southern Kennebec Valley regional planning committee from 1976 to 1978 Walter was appointed director of civil defense and public safety agent for Pittston in 1958 and was a member of he Pittston Volunteer Fire Department. He helped organize and served 10 years as a leader of the Pittston Star Workers 4-H Club. He also served as leader of the congregational church youth group and the Parent Teachers Club.

Besides his wife, Walter is sum² ad by his daughter and son-in-law, Pat and Jack Decker and their daughter, Janet; his brothers, Charles and wife, Anna Ricker, of Pittston, and Howard and wife, Stella, Ricker, of Wisconsin; his sisters, Betty King of Pittston and Ethe Pooler of Old Town; two godsons, Dale King of Pittston and Laurence Ricker of Wisconsin; and several nicees and nephews.
