Carrol E. Richardson, 73, former Portland and Peaks Island grocer and a resident of Greater Portland most of his life, died Wednesday afternoon in his home on Church Avenue, Peaks Island. He had been in failing health several weeks.

Born at Naples, Sept. 26, 1874, Mr. Richardson was the son of Charles B. and Mrs. A. Richardson. He was employed by the Foster-Avery Company here for several years before engaging in the grocery business, and at one time was a baker for the F. N. Calderwood & Son.

He was a member of Portland Lodge, No. 1, AF & AM; Unity Lodge, No. 8, IOOF; also of the Knights of Pythias and the Golden Cross.

Westbrook, May 28—Carroll M. Richardson, 57, former mayor and postmaster, died this evening in his home, 90 Haskell Street, following a long illness. He served as mayor in 1936. He was retired as postmaster May 29, 1934, after serving in that capacity for 12 years. He entered the postal service as a sub-carrier Jan. 1, 1904, was appointed regular clerk, April, 1905, and served as acting superintendent of the Cumberland Mills Station for several months. Mr. Richardson was appointed postmaster after the death of Clinton S. Eastman.

Mr. Richardson was active in civic and lodge activities, serving as president of the Westbrook Chamber of Commerce, president of the Rotary Club, of which he was an honorary member, chancellor of Presumpscott Valley Lodge, Knights of Pythias; grand chancellor of the Grand Domain of Maine, K. of P.; and secretary to the Warren Men's Club of the Warren Congregational Church of which he was a member. He was also a member of the Warren Phillips Lodge, F. A. & M. and a former member of the Republican City Committee.

He was a lifelong resident of this city, being born in the house in which he died. He was the son of the late Edwin and Kate Elwell Richardson.

Mr. Richardson is survived by his widow, Mrs. Carrie Stevens Richardson; a brother, Herbert C. Richardson of Portland; a sister, Mrs. Marshall H. Tyler of Kingston, R. I.; two daughters, Mrs. Phyllis Stigman and Mrs. Frances Gurney, both of this city; four sons, Wyvern E. Richardson of Portland; Shirley and Leonard Richardson, both of South Portland and Capt. Edwin W. Richardson of Paso Robles, Calif.; seven grandchildren and several nieces and

BRUNSWICK—Dr. C. Earle Richardson, 76, who suffered a

broken leg Saturday in a car accident in York, died Sunday afternoon at a Portland hospital.

Dr. Richardson, founder of Brunswick's first hospital and a practicing physician and surgeon in this town since 1926, had been in failing health for some time.

A native of Avon, where he was born March 14, 1885, to David and Clara F. Dickey Richardson, Dr. Richardson was graduated from Farmington High School, and from Bowdoin College in 1909. He served a year as principal of Freedom Academy and two as principal of Danforth High School.

He received his degree in 1916 at the Maine Medical School of Bowdoin College. He practiced briefly in Portland following an internship at the Maine General Hospital there, and moved to Skowhegan where he took over Somerset Hospital.

He was a member of United Lodge of Masons, of St. Paul's Chapter, Mount Vernon Council, and DeMolay Commandery of Skowhegan, Scottish Rite and Kora Temple Shrine.

SOUTH PORTLAND—Edward T. (Giant) Richardson, 82, of 282 Highland Ave., a veteran Maine court reporter, died today in a Portland hospital.

Mr. Richardson served in Maine courts from 1912 to 1960, when he became a free-lance stenographer. He had been known at one time as one of the most efficient and rapid shorthand writers in the state.

Mr. Richardson once told the Lions Club here that churches and homes should inspire children with the nobleness of virtue as a means of lessening crime. The possession of a sense of right, he declared, is far more valuable than the fear of external punishment.

He had been stenographer at about 50 Maine murder trials, including the trial of Francis M. Carroll, former South Paris deputy sheriff, for the murder of Dr. James G. Littlefield in 1938.

The longest case Mr. Richardson ever handled was that of Jenkins Petroleum Process Co. against the Sinclair Oil Co. in Federal Court in Portland. He was one of five stenographers who turned out vol-

umes of testimony for five weeks.

He was taught court reporting by his uncle, the late Charles O. Barrows, a court reporter here many years.

Mr. Richardson was a former Portland City Council member. He served from Ward 1 in 1921 and was a former alderman here from Ward 5 in 1925.

He also published in February, 1947, the longest court record in memory of Maine bench and bar—more than 2,200 pages of record testimony in the long-winded equity case brought by three Maine savings banks against the old Portland Railroad Co.

Mr. Richardson was known to many as "Giant," a contrast to his height of five feet, two inches.

He was born here Nov. 14, 1886, son of Daniel T. and Nellie Gurney Richardson. He attended Portland and Cornish schools and was graduated from Portland High School.

In 1916 he married Edith N. Trott of Peaks Island.

Mr. Richardson was a member of the American Legion, Sons of the American Revolution, Mount Vernon Chapter, Portland Council and Portland Lodge, all Masonic or-
