Windham, Sept. 7.—James F. Richardson, 90, a former caretaker at Great Diamond Island and cook in a logging camp and aboard ship, died today at the residence of Dr. and Mrs. Lawrence Bennett, Windham Hill Road, after a brief illness.

CAMDEN - Lloyd M. Richardson, 93, a retired dentist, died Tuesday at a Camden health care center.

He was born in Rockland, a son of Francis "Frank" A. & Harriet Elnora Holden Richardson, and attended Rockland schools, graduating from Rockland High School in the class of 1915 with honors.

Following high school he worked a short time with the former Bird Co. of Rockland. He then worked at Bath Iron Works until enlisting in the U.S. Army in 1918.

In the fall of 1919 he entered Harvard Dental School graduating with honors in 1923.

Following his graduation from Harvard, Dr. Richardson returned to this area and practiced dentistry in Thomaston with Dr. Edward Peaslee. In 1925 he established his own practice in Rockland where he specialized in children's dentistry and had one of the first operating rooms, specifically designed for children. For several years he held clinics on Vinalhaven and North Haven, flying there with his own equipment.

He was on the advisory boards of the former YMCA of Rockland and DeMolay.

Dr. Richardson was master of Aurora Lodge of Rockland in 1958, high priest of King Solomon Temple Chapter Ram, in 1956, master of King Hiram Council, R&SM, in 1958, and was commander of Claremont Commandery in 1950. He also holds membership in the Rockland Scottish Rite bodies, where he was past

sovereign prince. The supreme council conferred the 33rd degree on him.

He was also a member of the Elks Lodge, and was a 65-year member of the Penobscot View Grange. Dr. Richardson was a charter member of the Rockland Kiwanis Club, serving as president in 1942, and received the first life membership, holding 50 years of perfect attendance.

He was a life member of the American Dental Association, as well as the Maine Dental Association. For many years, he served as the official dentist for the local Red Cross Chapter. He attended the Pratt Memorial Methodist Church, and later the Port Clyde Advent Christian Church.

He was pre-deceased by his wife, Della Richardson, in 1987, and a stepson, Nathan G. Peasley Sr., in 1988.

He is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Vernon (Harriet) Thompson of Port Clyde, with whom he made his home from 1982 to 1988; two stepsons, Leroy F. Peasley Sr., of Rockland and Harold M. Peasley of Kensington, Conn., 18 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

A funeral service will be held at 1:00 p.m. Saturday at the Burpee-Strong Funeral Home, Rockland. Burial will follow in Seaview Cemetery.

**#4700 Noble William A. Richardson** of Sebec and Bangor was born in Bangor on January 22, 1907 and died at a Dexter nursing home on October 16, 1996.

He attended Bangor public schools, Kents Hill Seminary and Fordham University where he was a prominent athlete. He later completed the Graduate School of Banking at Rutgers University. In 1928 he began his banking career as a bookkeeper with the Merrill Trust Co. in Bangor. He
