

CAMDEN – Lloyd M. Richardson, 93, a retired dentist, died Tuesday at a Camden health care center.

He was born in Rockland, a son of Francis "Frank" A. & Harriet Elnora Holden Richardson, and attended Rockland schools, graduating from Rockland High School in the class of 1915 with honors.

Following high school he worked a short time with the former Bird Co. of Rockland. He then worked at Bath Iron Works until enlisting in the U.S. Army in 1918.

In the fall of 1919 he entered Harvard Dental School graduating with honors in 1923.

Following his graduation from Harvard, Dr. Richardson returned to this area and practiced dentistry in Thomaston with Dr. Edward Peaslee. Dr. Richardson was master of Aurora Lodge of Rockland in 1958, high priest of King Solomn Temple Chapter Ram, in 1956, master of King Hiram Council, R&SM, in 1958, and was commander of Claremont Commandery in 1950. He also holds membership in the Rockland Scottish Rite bodies, where he was past sovereign prince. The supreme council conferred the 33rd degree on him.


He was also a member of the Elks Lodge, and was a 65-year member of the Penobscot View Grange. Dr. Richardson was a charter member of the Rockland Kiwanis Club, serving as president in 1942, and received the first life membership, holding 50 years of perfect attendance.


