Addison Henry Rice of High street died at Dr. Wilson's hospital in Brunswick Saturday night after having been taken there for an emergency operation. He was born in Woolwich Sept. 1, 1866, the son of John and Catherine Lundrigan Rice. For many years he was in the service of the Dennison Mfg. Co., at South Framingham, Mass., after which he returned to Woolwich. Then he went to Harpswell, where he resided for a number of years, most of the time serving on the Board of Selectmen. Six years ago he came to Bath to make his home with his son, Earl A. Rice. His wife died in 1942.

Mr. Rice was a member of Solar lodge of Masons and of the Knights of Pythias in Brunswick. He was a member also of the Baptist church in Woolwich. Surviving him are his son, Earl A. Rice; a stepson, Charles Elkins, of Boston; three grandchildren and five great grandchildren.

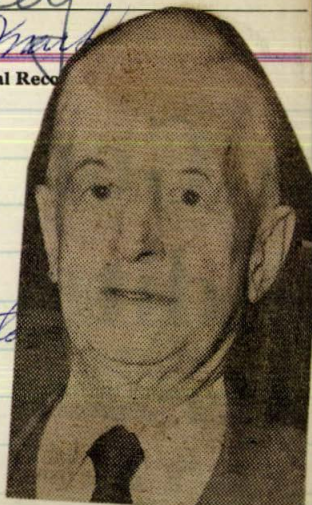
