



In 1886 he became associated with the Brunswick Savings Institution, devoting part of his time to work as its treasurer, and since 1903 the bank has occupied his full efforts.

In 1930 he succeeded the late Ellery C. Day as president of the institution, his son, Thomas Harrison Riley, Jr., assuming the post of treasurer He was one of the early presidents of the Savings Bank Association of Maine and was justly proud of his bank, which weathered the depression period and was of service to many clients in those troublous days.

Active in the affairs of the Town of Brunswick, Mr. Riley served 25 years, from 1886 to 1911, as town clerk, being succeeded on his retirement by his son, John Winchell Riley, who is carrying on the family insurance business, and who was last week elected town clerk for his 26th term

Since retiring as clerk, Mr. Riley has served the town on many important committees, including the Committee of 12, which prepares the

annual budget.

From 1894 to 1924 Mr. Riley was secretary of the Board of Overseers of Bowdoin College and at the commencement of 1924 was awarded the honorary degree of Master of Arts.

He was a member of United Lodge of Masons at Brunswick, a member of Alpha Delta Phi Fraternity, and had served many years as president of the Brunswick Public Library Association.

He is survived by a sister, Mrs. William J. Curtis of New York City and Camden; two sons, Thomas Harrison Riley, Jr., and John Winchell Riley of Brunswick; six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren,

consultant.


He attended the Congregational Church and was a member of the Masons, the Shrine, American Engineering Society, and Kappa Sigma Fra-


