was always a hard worker and a good provider for his family," said a daughter, Laurretta M. Nielsen.

Mr. Riley worked for the state Department of Corrections for 27 years, retiring in 1981. He was the farm manager and outside foreman of the Maine Correctional Center in South Windham. There, he was in charge of a dairy herd that produced milk, cream and ice cream for the correctional center, Pineland and the Maine Youth Center in South Portland.

He was the foreman for the correctional center's outdoor work crew, which provided services to several organizations in Windham.

A lifelong resident of Windham, he was a son of Osborne and Eva Pratt Riley. He attended local schools and graduated from Windham High School in 1934.

He married Leona M. Verrill in 1939. They recently celebrated 62 years of marriage.

Mr. Riley had a soft spot for animals — especially ponies and horses. In his early years, he owned and raised ponies and horses on his farm.

"What he loved best about having horses and ponies was teaching his children, grandchildren and friends to ride them," his daughter said. "He took great pleasure and pride in this.

"He was a devoted family man and a good friend," she added. "He enjoyed helping people. He was always ready to lend a hand to a friend or neighbor."

Mr. Riley was a member of the Kora Shrine and part of the Oriental Band Unit. As a member, he drove an eight-hitch team of ponies that pulled a wagon on which the band played during parades.

He was a member of the Highland Cliff Advent Christian Church in Windham; a member and past master of the Presumpscot Lodge of Masons; past patron of the Evangeline Chapter, Order of Eastern Star; past president of the Baraca Philathea Union Christian Organization; and a member of St. Alban Commandery.

After he retired, he bought a motorcycle. "He went riding with his friends often. It made my mother kind of nervous, but he loved it," his daughter said. He also enjoyed spending winters with his wife at their home in Lakeland, Fla., for the past 17 years.

Surviving are his wife; two sons, Gerald R. of Palmdale, Calif., and Ted L. of Windham; his daughter of Windham; nine grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

Visiting hours will be from 6 to 8 p.m. Sunday at Dolby Funeral Chapel, 434 River Road, where a funeral will be held at 10 a.m. Monday. Burial will be in the family lot at Chase Cemetery.

Brunswick, March 7—Thomas Harrison Riley, president of the Brunswick Savings Institution and for a generation one of the town's leading citizens, died at his home early this morning after an attack of coronary thrombosis Friday. He had been in good health until that time and in spite of his 79 years made it a practice to walk a mile or two about the village each evening.

Born in Philadelphia, July 26, 1857, the son of Thomas Harrison and Lydia Sturtevant Riley, he was graduated from St. Mark's School in 1876 and entered Bowdoin College as a

member of the Class of 1880. In 1879 he was married to Elizabeth Fuller Forsaith of Brunswick, who died in 1934, and after a brief period in business in Denver, Colo., he entered the Brunswick insurance firm of which his father-in-law was the head. In 1886 he became associated with the Brunswick Savings Institution, devoting part of his time to work as its treasurer, and since 1903 the bank has occupied his full efforts.

In 1930 he succeeded the late Ellery C. Day as president of the institution, his son, Thomas Harrison Riley, Jr., assuming the post of treasurer. He was one of the early presidents of the Savings Bank Association of Maine and was justly proud of his bank, which weathered the depression period and was of service to many clients in those troublous days.

Active in the affairs of the Town of Brunswick, Mr. Riley served 25 years, from 1886 to 1911, as town clerk, being succeeded on his retirement by his son, John Winchell Riley, who is carrying on the family insurance business, and who was last week elected town clerk for his 26th term.

Since retiring as clerk, Mr. Riley has served the town on many important committees, including the Committee of 12, which prepares the annual budget.

From 1894 to 1924 Mr. Riley was secretary of the Board of Overseers of Bowdoin College and at the commencement of 1924 was awarded the honorary degree of Master of Arts.

He was a member of United Lodge of Masons at Brunswick, a member of Alpha Delta Phi Fraternity, and had served many years as president of the Brunswick Public Library Association.

He is survived by a sister, Mrs. William J. Curtis of New York City and Camden; two sons, Thomas Harrison Riley, Jr., and John Winchell Riley of Brunswick; six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
