# John B. Roberts

## lawyer, legislator, municipal court judge

SANFORD — John B. Roberts, 78, a longtime lawyer, judge and active member of the Republican Party, died Thursday at H.D. Goodall Hospital.

Mr. Roberts practiced law continuously in Sanford from 1940 until his death, with the exception of when he served as a Navy ensign during World War II.

Mr. Roberts served a few years as register of deeds in York County and then was judge of probate for York County for 12 years in the late 1950s and 1960s.

Although a Republican, Mr. Roberts was popular with members of both political parties in his district. "He won elections even when the Democrats were at their strongest in the county," said a 1974 Press Herald story.

He served on many boards of charitable and service organizations, including the American Red

Cross, Camp Waban, United Way and Sanford-Springvale Kiwanis Club. He was a longtime trustee and director of the Sanford Institute for Savings, the former Sanford Savings and Loan Association and the Springvale National Bank. He was a 50-year member of the Maine and American bar associations. He was a member of the Masons, Scottish Rite Bodies and Kora Temple Shrine.

Mr. Roberts was a summer resident of Square Pond in Acton for the past 47 years, and was founder of Square Pond Association.

Born in Caribou, a son of John and Blanche Lamb Roberts, he was a 1932 graduate of Caribou High School. He graduated in 1936 from Bowdoin College and in 1940 from Boston University Law School.

Surviving are his wife of 47 years, Myra Sawyer Roberts of Sanford; two sons, Peter S. Roberts of Worcester, Mass., and Paul B. Roberts of Berwick; a daughter, Peggy A. Roberts of Sanford; and four grandchildren.

**SACO — John Kenneth Roberts, D.O., 72, of 88 North St. died Thursday at a Biddeford hospital.**

He was born in Portland, a son of Porter A. and Emma Tripp Roberts, and attended schools there. He graduated from Deering High School in 1931. He studied pre-med at the University of Maine and graduated from Kirksville (Mo.) College of Osteopathy and Surgery. He served an internship at Ottawa (Ill.) General Hospital and was the first intern at the Osteopathic Hospital of Maine in Portland.

He practiced medicine in Sanford for 13 years, specializing in anesthesia. He was chief anesthesiologist at the Saco Hospital and was in general practice after it closed.

He came here in 1961.

Dr. Roberts was a member of the American Osteopathic College of

Anesthesiologists, the Maine Osteopathic Association, the American Osteopathic Society and the board of the York County American Cancer Society. He was also a member of the First Congregational Church and a 50-year member of Ancient Landmark Lodge of Masons in Portland.

He was a member of the Biddeford-Saco Country Club.

## **Lendall G. Roberts**

**auto salesman, pilot, flight instructor**

Lendall G. Roberts, 85, of Ocean Avenue died Saturday at Maine Medical Center.

He was born in Lisbon Falls, a son of Harry and Althea Gifford Roberts, attended local schools and was a 1930 graduate of Lisbon Falls High School.

Shortly after high school Mr. Roberts started flying airplanes. In 1935 he purchased his own plane in Waterville, which became the first plane based at what later was the Brunswick Naval Air Station.

From 1930 until 1939 Mr. Roberts worked as a factory-trained motorcycle mechanic for Harley Davidson at Schott's Motorcycle in Lewiston. Before World War II, he trained students at Bowdoin College to become commercial pilots. For a year Mr. Roberts taught British and American students how to fly planes in Americus, Ga.

On July 24, 1942, he married Dorothy A. Powers.

During World War II, Mr. Roberts served in the Army Air Force. He entered as a second lieutenant and was discharged in March 1946 as a first lieutenant.

In 1945 Mr. Roberts and his family moved to Brunswick and in 1954 they moved to Portland.

Mr. Roberts worked as a commercial pilot transporting lobsters between Nova Scotia and Yarmouth, Maine. In 1953 he became a sales representative for Chaplin Motors in Portland, retiring in 1975.

Mr. Roberts was a member of the Brunswick Masonic Lodge and was a member of the Ancient and Secret Order of Quiet Birdmen.

Surviving besides his wife of Portland are two sons, Larry of Las Vegas, Nev., and Ronald of Staatsburg, N.Y.; a sister, Lorene Fowler of Lisbon Falls; and seven grandchildren.

Services will be private. Burial will be in the Maine Veteran's Memorial Cemetery, Augusta. Arrangements are by Stetson's Funeral Home, Brunswick.

## **LESLIE C. ROBERTS**

**BREWER** — Leslie C. Roberts, 81, husband of Winifred (Keezer) Roberts, beloved father and grandfather, died unexpectedly May 2, 1992, at his home. He was born in Brewer, Nov. 29, 1910, the son of George C. and Cora (Green) Roberts. Mr. Roberts was a graduate of Brewer High School and was employed by the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad as a fireman and engineer for 35 years, until his retirement in 1975. ## Lester Albert Roberts ✓ veteran road commissioner

ALFRED — Lester A. Roberts, 66, of Gore Road, a veteran road commissioner, died Friday at Maine Medical Center after being stricken at work Thursday.

He was first elected road commissioner in 1953, and served until 1973. He was returned to office in 1982 and served until his death.

### PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

He was re-elected in the annual town election Friday.

Townpeople held a moment of silence in his memory at Saturday's town meeting.

"He's one of the last of what a small town is all about," said Anne Roberts of Alfred, his daughter-in-law. "His whole life was this town."

Five years ago, a selectman urged that

Mr. Roberts be more accountable to selectmen. Mr. Roberts reacted by saying, "If I had to track down two selectmen before I did anything, I'd get nothing done."

Mr. Roberts learned the road business from Leland Gile before he retired in the 1950s, according to Barbara Roberts, his wife of 45 years.

When Gile retired, Mr. Roberts "bought Leland's equipment, which wasn't much — a truck and a plow," his wife recalled Sunday.

The thing he liked most about being road commissioner, she said, was "his daily communications with the people."

Mr. Roberts was born in Alfred, a son of Lester D. and Ertie Turbin Roberts, and attended local schools.

He worked on the family farm, and worked nights at the former Goodall-Sanford textile mills until he was drafted into the Army in 1952 during the Korean War. He returned to Alfred after being

discharged. Mr. Roberts was a former volunteer for the Alfred Fire Department for more than 25 years. He was a life member of the Fraternal Lodge, and was a member of the Brown-Emmons Post and the American Legion.

He was a former constable and dog officer and served as honorary grand marshal at the Alfred Festival in 1993.

Two of his sons died previously — Jon in 1972 and Nathan in 1974.

He is survived by his wife, Barbara Robbins Roberts of Alfred; a son, Dan of Alfred; a brother, Lawrence G. of Alfred; two sisters, Harriet I. Hall of Alfred and Janet O'Gara of Worcester, Mass.; and three grandchildren.

Porter A. Roberts, 70, secretary of the Maine Masonic Scottish Rite bodies since 1936 and for 19 years treasurer of the Portland Company, died suddenly early today at his home, 11 Florence Street. He was a 33rd Degree Mason.

Roberts had been ill several months, but had returned home from the hospital Friday and was believed recovering from a heart ailment.

Born at Lyman, May 15, 1881, he was the son of Alonzo and Viola J. Hill Roberts. He was graduated from Alfred High School in 1898 and from Gray's Business College, Portland, in 1900. He went to work for the First National Bank but after several years went to the Portland Company where he rose to treasurer in 1917. a post he held until he retired in 1936.

In 1912 Roberts began his Masonic affiliations which were to become a prominent part of his life. He was a past master of Ancient Landmark Lodge, which he joined that year; became treasurer of Greenleaf Chapter in 1933, a post he relinquished several years ago; was a past commander of Portland Commandary, Knights Templar; and a past thrice potent master of Yates lodge of Perfection.

He was also a member of Portland Council, all of the Scottish Rite Bodies and the Shrine. The 33rd degree was conferred upon him in 1939.

Roberts also was a past president of the Woodfords Club, and had served as vice president of the Maine Charitable Mechanics Association and as treasurer of the Portland and Kiwanis clubs.

He married Emma P. Tripp, who survives him, June 26, 1906. Also surviving are three sons, Charles A. and David L., both of Portland, and Dr. John K. Roberts of Sanford, and six grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Saturday in Woodfords Congregational Church. Interment will be in Greenwood Cemetery, Biddeford.

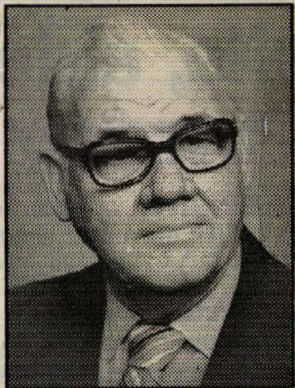
