YARMOUTH — Donald W. Robinson, a dedicated teacher who hosted a television program while in the Air Force, died at home June 24, 2000. He was 77, and had been ill for years.

He had impressive academic qualifications — a bachelor of science and a master's in education from the University of Maine, another master of science degree from Syracuse University and a Ph.D. from Boston University — yet Mr. Robinson had no pretense.



Mr. Robinson was born in Bradford, a son of Walter and Marie Bailey Robinson. He attended schools in Bradford and graduated from Higgins Classical Institute.

He served for four years with the Air Force as a navigator. Afterward, he spent many years in the Reserves.

He taught high school in Millinocket, Mattawamkeag and Yarmouth, and then was a science supervisor for the state Department of Education before

becoming a professor emeritus at the University of Maine at Farmington.

He was a 50-year member of the Masons and a member of the Lions Club.

His first wife, Eleanor Williams Robinson, died in 1959.

He is survived by his wife of 38 years, of North Yarmouth; five sons, Collin of Granby, Conn., Donald W. II of Ridgewood, N.J., Peter C. of Portland, Walter of Kittery and Matthew of Winchester, Mass; three daughters, Mary R. Grove of Limerick, Deborah R. Hiltz of Farmington and Rebecca R. Proulx of North Yarmouth; 10 grandchildren; and a great-granddaughter.

A memorial service will be held at 1 p.m. Wednesday, July 12, at St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Wilton, where he was a 25-year member.
