Herbert W. Robinson, 96, lifelong resident of Greater Portland and one of the oldest members of the Masonic fraternity in Maine, died this morning in the Mercy Hospital, where he had been a patient a week.

had been a patient a week. Mr. Robinson was born at Cape Elizabeth, Feb. 14, 1852, the son of Eben and Rachel Bartol Robinson, and received his schooling there. As a young man he became a bookkeeper, for many years being employed by A. Little & Company, former Middle Street wholesale dry goods dealers. At the turn of the century he entered the employ of the E. T. Burrowes & Company screen and billiard table manufacturers in this city, continuing as bookkeeper and accountant of the original company and of its successor until the late 1930's.

He was for 58 years a member of Portland Lodge, AF&AM and a past master of the lodge. Upon his completing 50 years as a member of the order the lodge observed Herbert W. Robinson Night, in June, 1939, which was featured by presentation of a 50year medal by the lodge. The occasion was attended by George F. Giddings of Augusta, then grand master of the Grand Lodge of Maine, and members of many subordinate lodges.

He also was a member of Greenleaf Chapter, Portland Council, St. Alban Commandery, Knights Templar, of which he was a past commander; the Scottish Rite bodies; a past wise master of the Rose Croix, and a member of the Knights of the Red Cross of Constantine. He was a member of Kora Temple, Order of the Mystic Shrine.

For many years Mr. Robinson was a trustee of Portland Lodge and also a member of the board of trustees of Portland Masonic Temple.

Mr. Robinson was long active in the Episcopal Church, having served as vestryman of St. Luke's Cathedral many years, a member of the vestry at the time of his death.

Surviving him is a daughter, Mrs. Charles Nason, Boston. His wife, Mrs. Carrie Small Robinson, died several years ago.

There will be a requiem celebration of Holy Communion at 9.30 a.m. Thursday in Emanuel Chapel of the Cathedral Church of St. Luke, and the burial office will be at 2.30 p. m. in the Cathedral. Burial will be in Everyreen Cemetery.
