Embert G. Robinson, 66, treasurer of Cummings Brothers, wholesale meat dealers, former member of the Portland School Board and long prominent in Republican politics in this City, died Thursday night following several months of failing health.

An aggressive leader in every activity in which he participated, Mr. Robinson took a leading part in civic affairs here and at Peaks Island, where he had a summer home. He had served as president of the Trefethen-Evergreen Improvement Association at the Island. Known for his independent views, he was one of the most colorful and positive members of the School Board, which he served from 1921 to 1928. He had also served in the Common Council under the former municipal form of government.

Mr. Robinson was born in Danville Junction, Auburn, Oct. 24, 1870, the son of Elbridge G. and Harriett Hunnewell Robinson. Following his graduation from the high school there he came to Portland and attended Gray's Business College. He entered the employ of Cummings Brothers soon after coming to this City, and had been treasurer of the company since 1916.

Known as "Mike" to his intimates, Mr. Robinson was for many years a leader in Republican politics in Ward 1, where he had resided most of the time since coming to this City. He was a former president of the Munjoy Club, and long served on the Republican City Committee. He had also served on the Municipal Recreation Commission. He was a member of the Masons, Odd Fellows, K. of P., Sons of Union Veterans, and Kora Temple, Order of the Mystic Shrine.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Susie Bynon Robinson; also by a daughter, Mrs. William Alfred Sterling, Jr., and three grandchildren in Claremont, N. H.; and a brother, Frank D. Robinson of Skowhegan.

Herbert W. Robinson, 96, lifelong resident of Greater Portland and one of the oldest members of the Masonic fraternity in Maine, died this morning in the Mercy Hospital, where he had been a patient a week.

Mr. Robinson was born at Cape Elizabeth, Feb. 14, 1852, the son of Eben and Rachel Bartol Robinson, and received his schooling there. 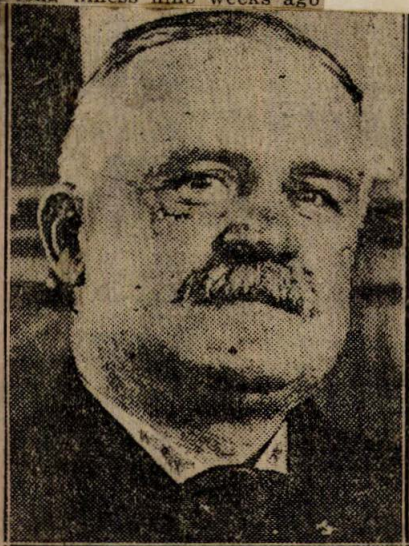
