**WATERVILLE** — James Frederick Robjent, 85, of 8 Cherry Hill Drive, died after a prolonged illness on Thursday, Aug. 28, 2003, at Lakewood Manor.

He was born Sept. 18, 1917, in Lawrence, Mass., the son of George F. and Mary B. Robjent. He was educated in the Andover, Mass., public schools, Phillips Andover Academy, Yale University and received a bachelor of science degree in civil engineering from Worcester Polytechnic Institute.

In 1943 he married Margaret Griscom Brick of Crosswicks, N.J.

During World War II, he served as captain in the Army Air Corps as Engineering Officer of the 313th Fighter Squadron, 50th Fighter Group with service in England, France and Germany. His awards included the Distinguished Unit Citation with cluster, ETO Ribbon with five Campaign Stars and the Bronze Star Medal for Meritorious Service during the Battle of the Bulge.

From 1940-1955 he lived in Andover, where he was a member of the South Church, president of the Andover Taxpayers Association, and adjutant of Post B, American Legion.

In 1955 he moved with his family to Waterville to become purchasing manager for Scott Paper Company in Winslow, a position he held until his retirement in 1983. He was co-founder and past president of the Purchasing Management Association of Maine, a member of the National Association of Purchasing Management, past director of the Mansfield Clinic, past di-

rector of the Waterville Osteopathic Hospital, a charter member and past president of the Waterville Safety Council, and a 50-plus year member of the American Legion.

He was a member of the First Congregational Church where he served for more than 30 years as assistant treasurer; a member of Waterville Lodge 33, A.F. & A.M.; Teconnet Chapter 52, R.A.M.; Mount Lebanon Council 13, R. & S.M.; St. Omer Commandry 12, Knights Templar; Kora Temple Shrine.

Survivors include his wife, Margaret; two sons, James Beckford Robjent of New London, N.H., Frederick Brick Robjent of Orchard Park, N.Y.; a daughter, Elizabeth (Bette) Griscom Crane of Oakland; two grandsons, J. Lawrence Robjent of Lake Placid, N.Y. and Thomas Wheeler Robjent of Alexandria, Va.; two granddaughters, Stacey and Stephanie Crane of Oakland; and his sister, Barbara Moore, of Barnstable, Mass.

There will be no visiting hours. A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. on Sunday, Aug. 31, at the First Congregational Church in Waterville. Internment will be at the convenience of the family at a later date in Crosswicks Cemetery, Crosswicks, N.J.

## **Ralph C. Rodgers** ✓ **former Sanford police chief**

WESTBROOK – Ralph C. Rodgers, 91, of East Bridge Street, a former Sanford police chief, died Friday at a local nursing home.

He was born in Sanford, a son of William and Chestina Parr Rodgers, and attended Sanford schools. He later moved to Springvale, where he lived for most of his life before moving here four years ago.

Mr. Rodgers joined the Sanford Police Department in December 1937 and by 1939 had worked his way up to first sergeant. He was later appointed chief in 1948 and served in that position for 18 years.

During his career there, the department grew from a one-man operation that was located in a single room to a 17-member department, plus two dispatchers, that worked out of a wing in Town Hall.

In a 1955 salute to Rodgers by the Portland Press Herald, the chief was described as "Sanford's answer to crime and corruption. . . ."

In 1960, Rodgers was named Sanford's citizen of the year by the Sanford-Springvale Memorial Post of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Mr. Rodgers was a member of the Sanford Lions, Sanford Elks, Lebanon Grange and Springvale Lodge of Masons, of which he was past master.

In addition to working with the police department, Mr. Rodgers was once employed as a weaver in the Sanford-Goodall Mills.

His wife, Marjorie Patch Rodgers, died in 1983.

Surviving are a son, William H. Rodgers; and two granddaughters.

Funeral services will be at 11 a.m. Monday at the Hay Funeral Home, Westbrook. Burial will be in Newfield.

Bar Harbor, Oct. 15. (AP)—David J. Rodick, 52, Bar Harbor banker and attorney and former Republican State Committeeman from Hancock County, died here today.

A native of this community, Rodick attended the University of Maine and Boston University Law School. He was president of the Bar Harbor Banking and Trust Company and was a World War I veteran.

Greenville, July 2.—Adelbert G. Rogers, 67, of Greenville, died suddenly of a heart attack, July 8, as he and Mrs. Rogers were returning from a few days in camp at Dollar Island, Moosehead Lake.

Funeral services were from the Greenville Union Church, July 11, the Rev. Ralph J. Barron, pastor of the Greenville Junction Methodist Church, officiating. Members of Columbia Lodge and Mowidausis Chapter, O.E.S., attended in a body. Bearers were Greenville friends, C. B. Hamilton, J. H. Brown, George Mountain, E. B. Crowley, T. H. Poole, C. B. Sawyer, A. D. Sanborn, and J. W. Kierstead. Interment was in Greenville Cemetery.

Mr. Rogers was born in North Guilford, July 17, 1872, his family moving to Greenville while he was still very young, and he has since lived here. He was graduated from Greenville High School and attended Coburn Classical Institute and Bucksport Seminary. At the age of 17 he engaged in lumbering operations in this vicinity. He followed this work with his father for many years, afterward becoming deputy sheriff from Greenville in the Piscataquis County jurisdiction in 1909.

In that same year he was elected tax collector to the Town of Greenville, holding this office until the time of his death, except for one year. In 1929 he became representative to the Maine legislature and served two consecutive terms. He was a Past Master of Columbia Lodge, F. and A. M., and Past Patron of Mowidausis Chapter, O.E.S., of Greenville. Mr. Rogers was devoted to his family and all the best interests of his community and State.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Otelia Rogers; one daughter, Mrs. John Almy of Providence, R. I.; two sons, Howard L. Rogers of Bath and F. Wyman Rogers of Worcester, Mass.; two sisters, Mrs. Mabel Holt of Portland and Mrs. William H. Hilton of Bangor; two brothers, William Rogers of Braintree, Mass., and H. Alton Rogers of Hawali; eight grandchildren; and a daughter-in-law, Mrs. Addie Rogers of Rockland.
