HAROLD E. ROGERS

BRUNSWICK — Harold Eugene Rogers, 75, of 154 McKeen St., died Saturday at his home following a long illness.

He was born at Orrington, Feb. 10, 1893, son of Frank and Cora Ross Rogers.

Mr. Rogers attended Orrington schools and was graduated from Brewer High School. He was an electrical engineer and for many years was employed at the Bangor House and for the Maine Central Railroad.

In 1939 he married the former Elizabeth A. Callinan. He moved here in 1941 founding the H. E. Rogers Heating Co. He retired in 1957.
