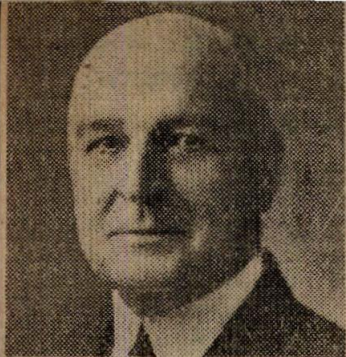

Funeral services for Charles Henry Ross, 84, more than 60 years connected with the grocery business in Portland and one of the oldest members of the trade in Maine, will be at 2 p. m. Saturday at 749 Congress Street. Interment will be in Pine Grove Cemetery, Falmouth.

Mr. Ross, ill 10 months, died Thursday night in a local hospital, where he had been a patient but three days.

Born in Portland, Dec. 11, 1856, and a life-long resident of the City, Mr. Ross was identified with the grocery business from early manhood, and in 1884 engaged in business with F. H. Morrill under the firm name of Morrill & Ross. After the death of his partner in 1911, he continued the business alone until 1919, when he closed the store. He

soon after entered the employ of the Chipman store, later going to the George C. Shaw upper Congress Street store upon the former business being discontinued. For several years Mr. Ross operated a store summers at Great Diamond Island. The first few years after the opening of Station WCSH he was announcer for the Chipman Studio program and was said to have been the oldest radio announcer in the United States.

For 18 years Mr. Ross served on the Board of Overseers of the Poor, several years as chairman, until 1910. He was an original member of the First Radio Parish of America and the 13 Class, also a member of the Masons, including the Knights Templar, the Shrine, Odd Fellows, and Knights of Pythias.

He married Miss Donna E. Howe of Augusta in 1881 and last year they observed the 59th anniversary of their marriage at their home, 33 Crescent Street, where they resided half a century.

LONG ISLAND — Harlan F. Ross, 72, a superintendent of the fuel depot on Long Island, part-time lobster fisherman and former baseball star, died Sunday at a Portland hospital after a brief illness.

For 37 years, Mr. Ross was a civil service employee for the Navy. He worked in fuel management at Navy fuel

depots in Subic Bay, Philippines; Rota, Spain; and in Harpswell, Brunswick and Long Island, Maine.

He retired from government service in 1980, and two days later he went to work managing the fuel depot for the new owners, King Resources. He later took the same job for Phoenix Resources of Oldahoma when it took over the depot.

Mr. Ross was a part-time lobster fisherman most of his life.

"He really and truly loved to go out on the boat early in the morning," said a daughter, Leslie Ross-Papkee of Portland. "He was up before everybody, and off he went."

During his retirement, Mr. Ross only tended to about 35 traps. "He lost money, but we always had fresh lobster," his daughter said.

He recently gave his boat and lobster gear to his two eldest grandsons. "It was with the stipulation that he would always get lobsters at boat price," she said.

"Everyone on the island really liked Harlan," said Mary Ross, his sister-in-law. "His mother was a Johnson, so that made him related to almost every other person on the island."

A 1941 Portland High School graduate, Mr. Ross played shortstop on Portland High's state champion baseball team that year. He also led the league in batting.

"He didn't like school that much," said his older brother, George Ross of Long Island. "Not until he got to playing baseball."

"He had the best reflexes of anyone I've ever seen," said Donald MacVane, a lifelong friend. "I watched him one time grab three live flies at the same time."

"Harley came from a rather poor family," MacVane said. "He was left-handed and he never had a glove, so when he went out for baseball at Portland High he had to wear his father's glove backwards. Well, he was so good that the coach took him the first day after practice down to James Bailey's (a sporting goods store) and bought him a new glove."

"They had some real fine island teams during his heyday," MacVane said. "Whatever position we needed on the team, he played it. If World War II didn't come along when it did, I suspect he might have gone somewhere as a baseball player."

Mr. Ross served in the Navy during World War II as a torpedoman in the Pacific Theater of Operations.

A native of Long Island, he was one of eight children of Frederick and Nellie Johnson Ross.

Mr. Ross enjoyed traveling, hunting and memorizing poetry. He was a 32nd degree Scottish Rite Mason and a member of the Kora Temple, the Long Island Veterans of Foreign Wars Post and Long Island Methodist Church.

Also surviving are his wife of 45 years, Cynthia Stevens Ross; a son, Steven of North Yarmouth; another daughter, Stacy Ross Scott of Hampden; and seven grandchildren.

Linwood Franklin Ross deputy secretary of state

READFIELD — Linwood Franklin Ross, 66, of Lakeview Drive, twice a deputy secretary of state and the state purchasing agent for seven years, died Sunday at his winter home in Barefoot Bay, Fla., following a long illness. *62-17-1989*

He was born in Calais, and had been a winter visitor of Barefoot Bay for several years.

Mr. Ross retired as deputy secretary of state after 24 years employment with the State of Maine.

Mr. Ross, a Democrat, served as deputy secretary of state from 1964 to January 1967 when he was fired by incoming Secretary of State Joseph Edgar, a Republican.

Because the Legislature had passed a law in 1965 making deputy secretary of state a non-political post subject to civil service, Mr. Ross appealed his firing but the Maine Supreme Court ruled the law unconstitutional. He went to work as a special assistant to newly elected Gov. Kenneth M. Curtis, who had named him to the deputy secretary of state's post.

He served again as deputy secretary of state from January 1975 to Dec. 31, 1988.

From 1969 to 1975, Mr. Ross served as the state purchasing agent, resigning when he was named a second time as deputy secretary of state.

Before beginning his career in state government, he worked in Presque Isle with Suburban Propane Gas Co. and eventually became its district manager for southern Maine and New Hampshire.

Mr. Ross came to Portland from Calais during World War II and worked in the South Portland shipyard as a welding expediter.

He was a 32nd degree Mason with the South Portland Lodge, a member of the Kora Temple Shrine in Lewiston, and chairman of the Northern District of the AAMVA New England State.

He attended the Palm Bay Methodist Church in Palm Bay, Fla.

He is survived by his wife of 43 years, Olive Ross of Readfield and Barefoot Bay, Fla.; a son, Kurt of Wayne; three brothers, Milton and Donald, both of Princeton, and Raymond of Eliot; three sisters, Elaine Carter of Stratham, N.H., Helen Pollard of Barefoot Bay, and Ruth Ross of Portland; and two grandchildren.
