Ralph E. Rowe

Ralph E. Rowe, 70, of 71 West Street, retired teacher and supervisor of penmanship in the local schools for 50 years, died Wednesday evening in a local hospital.

Mr. Rowe, who had been manager of the Peaks Island House and the Hamilton House at Chebeague Island, had been in failing health for over a year.

Son of William A. and Catherine Rowe, Mr. Rowe was born at Holden, Sept. 4, 1872 and was educated in schools there and at Eddington. He attended Westbrook Seminary where he later taught. He attended Salem, Mass. Normal School and Brown University at Providence, R. I. He was made supervisor of penmanship in the Deering District in 1899, and assistant supervisor in Portland.

In 1915, Mr. Rowe was elected supervisor of penmanship in the Portland District and in 1921 became principal of the Evening School, a post he resigned in 1940. He retired as supervisor of the Portland-Deering districts in 1942.

He had written a book, Pointers on Penmanship, and had held offices in the Naional Association of Penmanship Supervisors. He had been president of the New England Penmanship Association.

For four years president of the Portland Teachers' Association, Mr. Rowe was also president of the Schoolmasters Club.

He was an attendant of the Congress Square Universalist Church, and member of the Ancient Landmark Lodge, Order of Masons.

He is survived by a sister, Miss Margaret Rowe, Portland; five daughters, Mrs. Robert A. Moore, Arlington, Mass.; Mrs. Frank O'Brion, Meriden, Conn.; Mrs. Charles W. Vickerson, Portland; Mrs. Richard W. Soule, Hyannis, Mass.; and Mrs. Ernest A. Bayliss, Pleasantville, N. Y.; four grandchildren, Marilyn and Robert Moore and Sally and David Bayliss.

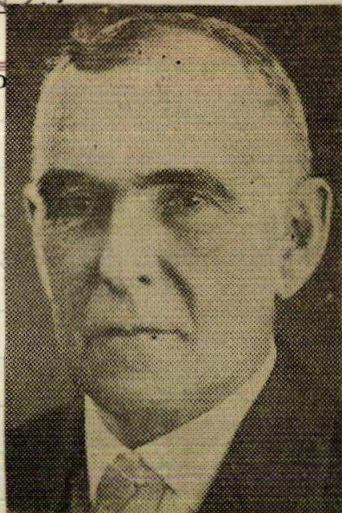

In failing health for a year, Seth E. Rowe, 73, grand treasurer of the Grand Lodge of Knights of Pythias of Maine and formerly a resident of South Portland, died Tuesday night in his home at Intervale, New Gloucester. Funeral services will be held in his home Friday at 1.30 p. m.

Mr. Rowe, in his earlier life, followed the sea for many years, later commanding vessels. He then became head bookkeeper for the Marine Hardware Company of South Portland, leaving about seven years ago to engage in the poultry business in Intervale. In the latter line he had built up an extensive business.

Joining Boothbay Lodge, No. 32, of Boothbay Harbor on March 5, 1900, Mr. Rowe from that time on was actively and prominently identified with the Knights of Pythias. He became chancellor commander of his lodge, Jan. 1, 1904, and was also a member of Fleur de Lis Company, Uniform Rank, K. of P., and El Maina Temple, 203, D. O. K. K. in this City, becoming a royal prince in the latter organization.

He served the grand lodge as grand outer guard, grand inner guard, master of arms and as prelate before being advanced to grand keeper of the exchequer. He was also a member of Myrtle Temple, Pythian Sisters, and of Hiram Lodge, F. & A. M., both in South Portland.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Flora Rowe, a past grand chief of the Grand Temple of Pythian Sisters; a daughter and two grandchildren.

He retired in 1983 at age 77.

WILLIAM H. ROWE of West Buxton, prominent Maine business man, former town official of Buxton and known widely as developer of one of the leading trout hatcheries in this part of the Country, died this morning in the Maine General Hospital, where he had been a patient four weeks. He had been in failing health for some time.

Private funeral services will be held Sunday afternoon at Neal's undertaking parlors at Gorham. Interment will be in Moss Side Cemetery at Cumberland Center.

Mr. Rowe was born at Parkman, Sept. 9, 1872, the son of Thomas and Mary Sargent Arnold. Following the death of his father he was adopted when five years of age by the family of Freeman Rowe of Cumberland. He received his education in the schools of that town and Portland.

Later removing to Buxton, Mr. Rowe served as a selectman there in 1922, 1923 and 1924 and in other town offices. He also was prominent in civic organizations and was a member of the Pine Tree Fish and Game Association and a past president of Maine State Fish and Game Association and the Cumberland County Fish and Game Association. He was in much demand as a speaker on log and fish culture and was frequently by service clubs and organizations.

Rowe joined the Masonic fraternity in Portland, afterwards transferring his membership to Buxton, where he served as worshipful master in 1924. He was also a member of Pleasant River Chapter, O. E. of the Odd Fellows and Red Men. Among the Masons he was affiliated with was a member of Kora Temple, I. O. of the Shrine, of Lewiston.

"He enjoyed his job very much," said his son, Michael of Belle Harbor, N.Y. "He was a salesman and proud of it. He characterized himself as having a salesman personality, but not with the negative connotations."

A longtime musician, Mr. Rubinoff played

trombone in Rudy Vallee's band while at the University of Maine.

"He was very proud of the fact that he knew (Vallee)," his son said. "He talked about it quite a bit. They were in touch once or twice over the years."



In 1915, Mr. Rubinoff helped to start the Portland High School Band, according to his son. "On his own, somehow he got a trombone, he worked for it, and he took lessons. He played many instruments over the years - trombone, saxophone, cello. I remember him starting lessons on the cello when I was in my

Mr. Rubinoff played trombone for a while in the Portland Symphony Orchestra. During the 1920s and 1930s, he played in (Lester) Romaine's Band and also Chandler's Band, both well known local groups.

During the 1950s, Mr. Rubinoff and two partners owned and ran the Casco Bay Lines island ferry service. "He enjoyed that immensely, although I think financially it was a flop," his son said.

Mr. Rubinoff was a director and board chairman of Shaarey Tphiloh Synagogue, and was in the group responsible for moving the synagogue during the 1950s from Newbury Street to its current location on Noyes Street. He was on the boards of the Portland Hebrew School and the Portland Hebrew Day School.

He was a longtime president of the Portland Chevra Kadisha, the Jewish Burial Society, and he worked hard on the fund-raiser to build the Abraham & Fanny Lervey Jewish Funeral Chapel on Doering Avenue.

Mr. Rubinoff was a 32nd degree Mason and sang with the Chanters, the Masonic chorus, which he conducted for two years. He also sang in the choir at Shaarey Tphiloh Synagogue. He was a grand chancellor of the Knights of Pythias.

Born in New York City, he graduated from Portland High School.

Surviving are his wife of 57 years, Sadie Abbing Rubinoff; his son, Michael, of Belle Harbor, N.Y.; and a grandson, Ari Rubinoff of Boca Raton, Fla.

A funeral will be held at 2 p.m. today at the Abraham & Fanny Lervey Funeral Chapel, 471 Doering Ave. Rabbi Marc Mandell will officiate. Burial will follow in Mt. Sinai Cemetery, Hicks Street. Arrangements are by the Jewish Funeral Home.
