Funeral services for Frank A. Rumery, prominent Portland contractor and YMCA official, will be held Tuesday at 2 p. m. at the Hay and Peabody Funeral Home. Interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery.

Mr. Rumery died Saturday at his home, 9 Ricker Park, after a long period of failing health. He was 79.

Coming to Portland from Hollis when he was 16 years old, Mr. Rumery served a three-year apprenticeship before becoming a partner in the contracting firm of Smith and Rumery, of which he later was president.

After he formed his own contracting firm, Mr. Rumery built, among other structures, the Masonic Temple, YMCA, Portland Boys' Club, the Maine General Hospital Pavilion Wing, the A & P Warehouse, Henley-Kimball Garage, Ricker Park Apartments, and a large section of "automobile row" on Forest Avenue.

Mr. Rumery also built the YMCA in Auburn, a high school and bank in Fort Fairfield, and structures in Presque Isle, Hebron, and Rockland. In New Hampshire he constructed a high school and bank in Ber'in, and a hospital in Wentworth.

During World War I, he operated a shipyard for construction of wooden vessels in South Portland.

Mr. Rumery was a past president of Opportunity Farm, New Gloucester, and a director for both the state and local YMCA.

He was a member of the Masons and Odd Fellows and formerly of the Woodfords Club. He was at one time associated with the Forest City Trust Company and was prominent in the city's financial life. In 1924 he began a term as one of the City's assessors, serving at a salary of \$1 annually.
