Mr. Russell was a summer resident of Green Landing, East Boothbay, since 1906.


During the late 1960s and early 1970s, he operated a summer business here with his family.







Mr. Ryder was a carpenter most of his life until his retirement in 1967 from the Kennedy Construction Co., and had previously worked for T.A. Houston.


He was a member of the Hiram Masonic Lodge in South Portland, the Scottish Rites, and the Kora Temple in Lewiston.
