## Stuart Morrell Ryder popular owner of Town Landing Market

Stuart Morrell Ryder, 56, a lifelong grocer who owned and operated Town Landing Market in Falmouth Foreside for the past 15 years, died Saturday in his home at 1052 Congress St. He apparently died of a self-inflicted gunshot wound, according to investigators.

Before buying Town Landing Market, Mr. Ryder

worked 24 years for John P. Martin at the former 20th Century Market and later at the former Martin's Foods. He worked at the Mill Creek Martin's in South Portland and later transferred to the Martin's at Falmouth Foreside.

At Town Landing Market, Mr. Ryder was known for his friendly manner, his willingness to put the interests of his customers first, and his love of animals. All dogs that came into the store were given a treat, and Mr. Ryder adopted a few

neighborhood dogs as store mascots.

### PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper is one obituary seeks to learn about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. It looks for a person who has made a mark on the community or on a person's family and the lives of friends in life but lasting ways.

In 1991, Mr. Ryder and the store's then mascot, Jerry the Beagle, were featured in a national Coca-Cola television commercial.

"He was one of the nicest guys I ever met," said Harold Wiley, a longtime customer. "He came into this small store under a lot of tough competition. He did a hell of a job, and people flocked to him because of his personality and his sincerity. He would do you any kind of a favor. If a customer was elderly or sick and they needed groceries, they could call him and he'd deliver."

Before he developed a serious heart ailment in February 1994, Mr. Ryder worked seven days a week, often putting in 15-hour days.

"Even when he was a kid at 15, he was always working," said his brother, Linwood Ryder.

Mr. Ryder started in the grocery business as a teen-ager, working first for the former Reed's Market, located near his home on Congress Street near Union Station.

"He truly liked the business," said his brother. "When he bought his own store, he said 'I'll be working just as hard as I always have, but now I'm doing it for myself.'"

"The store was his home," said Daniel Groves, who worked with Mr. Ryder at the market and before that at Martin's. "When he struck a deal for the store (with former owner Tom Randall) it was like a dream come true for Stu. He put every nickel he had on the line."

"He really appreciated the customers," said Groves. "It was a community market, and he always said if it wasn't for these people coming, it would never be possible."

"He was popular not only with the neighbors, but with animals," said Jeffrey McCue, a longtime friend who worked for Mr. Ryder at Martin's. "You'd go in there at any time and you'd see some of the neighborhood dogs. He even had beds for them."

The only recreation Mr. Ryder found time for was an occasional ride in his boat, Town Landing I, which he kept at Town Landing down the street from the store.

Born in Portland, a son of Delbert and Mary Ryder, he graduated in 1957 from Portland High School, and attended Portland University night school. He served in the National Guard in the early 1960s.

He was a 25-year member of the Deering Lodge of Masons and Kora Temple Shrine, and a 30-year member of Scarborough Fish & Game Association.

Surviving are his brother, Linwood, a niece, Alexandra I. Ryder, and a nephew, Christopher D. Ryder, all of California.

Mr. Ryder's parents, a brother, Delbert, and a sister, B. Constance Ryder, all died previously.

# R. A. Ryerson Dies In Auburn

## Twice Member Of Maine House

Special Despatch to The Press Herald

Auburn, Sept. 9—Rutellus Andrew Ryerson, 81, former State Representative and nine years a city official, died today at his home, 147 Lake Street, Auburn, after a long illness.

Mr. Ryerson served as Representative to Legislature from Livermore and Turner in 1895 and 1897, and after coming to Auburn in 1910 he served on the Board of Assessors for nine years, and was its chairman for six. He was a trustee of the Auburn Public Library, a director of the Auburn Savings and of the Mechanic Savings Banks; and he was long active in the Court Street Baptist Church, serving as moderator and deacon many years. He was also a member of the Masons and had held state offices in the Grange.

While a resident of Livermore, he was superintendent of schools for nine years, and was a member of the school committee for 17 years.

Mr. Ryerson was born at Livermore, the son of Andrew J. and Columbia Lyford Ryerson. In 1883 he married Bessie E. Chase of Livermore, who died three years later, and in 1898
