BOCA RATON, Fla. — Herman Der Sahagian, 94, died Aug. 12, 1989, at a private hospital.

He was born in Armenia, Jan. 1, 1895, and moved to the United States at age 15.

Mr. Sahagian founded the Fairview Wine Corp. in Gardiner, Maine, in 1947, and the Whitehouse Appliance Corp. in 1955 in Waterville.

A former Maine legislator, he was a member of the House of Representatives in the 100th through the 104th legislative sessions. During his tenure, he served on the Appropriations Committee and was the first Republican from the House named to the Intergovernmental Relations Commission. While in the House, Mr. Sahagian sponsored a bill to create the opportunity of a free trade zone for Maine, allowing foreign crude oil to be accepted and refined here.

Mr. Sahagian also served on a federal regional export expansion council. He also had been a Belgrade, Maine, selectman and held posts in the local and state Republican committees.

He moved to Fort Lauderdale from Belgrade Lakes, Maine, 16 years ago, and to the Whitehall Nursing Home in Boca Raton about a month ago.

He was member of the Lions Club, Rotary Club and the Masons of Maine and Florida.

He is survived by his wife, Stella (Derderian) Sahagian of Fort Lauderdale; three daughters, Virginia Der King of Fort Lauderdale, Anita Der Cook of Deerfield Beach and Belgrade Lakes, and Dorothy Der Silvano of Pompano Beach; a son, Herman "Ted" Der Sahagian Jr. of Fort Lauderdale; seven grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

A funeral service was held Aug. 16, 1989 at St. David Armenian Church in Boca Raton.

SOUTH PORTLAND — Theodore V. Sale, 85, of South Portland, who traveled extensively to locales seldom visited by tourists, died Wednesday at the Viking Nursing Home in Cape Elizabeth. He was a former resident of Cape Elizabeth and Portland.

After retiring, he traveled extensively, visiting five continents. Mr. Sale avoided posh resorts, choosing instead more primitive trips like going down the Amazon River in a native boat.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

When restrictions were relaxed during the Carter administration, allowing travel to Cuba, he was one of the first to go there. He wrote several articles for the Maine Sunday Telegram about his most exciting journeys.

As a member of the Volunteer Program, he showed slides of his trips to nursing home resi-

dents, shut-ins, lodge members, church groups and schools. "He did very well in talking about his slides — almost as if you had been there for every one of them," said a friend, Pauline Morris.

In 1966 he received recognition from the Maine Legislature for his "Contribution of Excellence in Education" in the Volunteer Program.

Some of Mr. Sale's favorite trips included Morocco, Iceland and visiting Mayan and Incan ruins in Central and South America.

He enjoyed walking, riding his bicycle and swimming to stay in shape. Morris said she and Mr. Sales also enjoyed round-dancing.

He also loved gardening, and was proud of the home he built in Cape Elizabeth. He loved animals, and had a cat named Turbo for several years.

Mr. Sale was a former resident of Cape Elizabeth.

He was born in Tampa, Fla., the son of John M. and Myrtle Lothrop Sale, and attended primary schools in Tampa.

The family moved to Portland in 1927. He attended schools in Portland, graduating from Portland High School in 1932.

He graduated from Eastern Radio Institute of Boston in 1935 and for the next two years was a maritime radio operator. He operated one of the last "spark" shipboard installations on the Atlantic Coast. Many friends often called him "Sparks."

In 1937 he went to work at radio station WCAX in Burlington, Vt. He returned to Portland in 1940, joining the technical staff of what was then the Guy Gannett radio station WGAN.

During World War II, he served in the Coast Guard, graduating from the Naval Air Technical Training Command school in Georgia as a specialist in radio aides to air navigation. After the war he returned to WGAN and remained there until his retirement in 1975.

He was a member of Corner Stone Masonic Lodge, the Scottish Rite Bodies of Portland, and was a retired member and past president of the Broadcast Engineers Local of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers. He also was a past president of the South Portland/Cape Elizabeth Historical Society.

Mr. Sale was a communicant of Old St. Paul's Anglo Catholic Church of Portland. He was an amateur radio operator with call letters W1BZS.

There are no survivors. Visiting hours will be from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. today at the Hobbs Funeral Home, 230 Cottage Road, South Portland. A requiem Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday in St. Paul's Anglican Church, 279 Congress St., Portland.
