He attended local schools and graduated from Crosby High School in Belfast, Class of 1926. He married Doris R. McKay in 1935. Mrs. Sanborn died in October of 1984. Mr. Sanborn was employed by the U.S. Government as an electrical foreman at the Brunswick Naval Air Station from 1941 to 1945, in Bermuda from 1945 to 1950 and at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba from 1950 to 1966. In 1968, he went to work for the state of Maine as state electrical inspector, retiring in 1978. He was a member of the Polar Star Lodge of Masons, Dunlap Commandry No. 5, the Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston, the Bath Lodge of Elks, the Toastmasters International, the National Rifle

Association, and the Maine Sportsmen's Association. He was also a staunch supporter of the National Republican Committee. Surviving him are four sons, James L. Sanborn of West Bath, Robert B. Sanborn of Newcastle, J. Michael Sanborn of Contoocook, N.H., and Donald B. Stackhouse of North Reading, Mass.; a daughter, Mrs. Jeffrey (Ellen) Parker of Bath; a brother, Maurice Sanborn of Lewiston; 11 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. Former Superior Court Justice Lauren M. Sanborn, 81, died today in St. Andrew's Hospital after a long illness.

Judge Sanborn was a former state senator and served two terms as state representative from South Portland. He was prominent in Greater Portland and Maine legal circles for many years.

A native of Baldwin, he was born there July 1, 1871, son of James M. and Hannah Plaisted Sanborn. He attended the schools there and Limington Academy. He was a graduate of Bates College and was a member of its Board of Trustees at the time of his death.

Judge Sanborn was admitted to the bar in 1900 while he was teaching school at Gardiner. He became superintendent of schools at South Portland in 1903, retiring three years later to devote full time to his law practice.

He was appointed resident justice of the Cumberland County Superior Court by Gov. Carl E. Milliken in February, 1918, and served a seven-year term.

As a judge and also as a legislator, Judge Sanborn was a foe of lax divorce laws.

"If I had my way, I would never permit anyone to have a divorce," he declared one day in 1924 as he handed down 33 divorces, x x x "but I have to follow the law and grant divorces according to the law."

Four years earlier he appeared at a welfare workers annual conference to plead for stronger divorce laws.

Judge Sanborn was one of the state's most prolific orators and demands for his services took him to every corner of the state. He is survived by his widow,

Anna White Davenport Sanborn, whom he married at Gardiner in 1944. He resided here for the past few years.

Funeral services will be at 11 a. m. Saturday at Christ Church, Gardiner. Interment will be at Oak Grove Cemetery, Gardiner.

He was born in Standish, son of Fred B. and Mary Owen Sanborn. He was a graduate of Standish High School and a 1927 graduate of the University of Maine at Orono.

For many years Mr. Sanborn was president of the York Mutual Insurance Co. of Maine, retiring in 1975. He was also chairman of the board of the Gorham Savings Bank, retiring in 1977.

He was a member and past master of Standish Lodge of Masons, past grand master of the Grand Lodge of Maine, served as high priest of Eagle Chapter, Commander in Chief of Maine Consistory, and grand sovereign of the Grand Council of Maine, Knights of the Red Cross of Constantine. He was a state legislator representing Gorham for six years, and for four years served on the governor's executive council. Former Gov. John Reed appointed him a *dedimus* justice and he served in this capacity until the time of his death.

His wife, Lena Burnham Sanborn, died in 1985.

He is survived by a sister, Louise S. Gray of Standish.
