Former Superior Court Justice Lauren M. Sanborn, 81, died today in St. Andrew's Hospital after a long illness.

Judge Sanborn was a former state senator and served two terms as state representative from South Portland. He was prominent in Greater Portland and Maine legal circles for many years.

A native of Baldwin, he was born there July 1, 1871, son of James M. and Hannah Plaisted Sanborn. He attended the schools there and Limington Academy. He was a graduate of Bates College and was a member of its Board of Trustees at the time of his death.

Judge Sanborn was admitted to the bar in 1900 while he was teaching school at Gardiner. He became superintendent of schools at South Portland in 1903, retiring three years later to devote full time to his law practice.

He was appointed resident justice of the Cumberland County Superior Court by Gov. Carl E. Milliken in February, 1918, and served a seven-year term.

As a judge and also as a legislator, Judge Sanborn was a foe of lax divorce laws.

"If I had my way, I would never permit anyone to have a divorce," he declared one day in 1924 as he handed down 33 divorces, x x x "but I have to follow the law and grant divorces according to the law." Four years earlier he appeared at a welfare workers annual conference to plead for stronger divorce laws.

Judge Sanborn was one of the ate's most prolific orators and emands for his services took im to every corner of the state He is survived by his widow.
