SOUTH CHINA — William Sanderson, 91, of the Windsor Road died Thursday, Dec. 19, 1996, at an Augusta nursing care center.

He was born in Irvine, Scotland, on March 15, 1905, the son of William and Sarah (Rowat) Sanderson.

He was employed by Hollingsworth & Whitney Co. (which became Scott Paper Co. and is now Kimberly-Clark), retiring as a millwright after 45 years.

He was a member of the Waterville Lodge of Masons, a Scottish Rite 32nd Degree Mason, a member of St. Omer Commandery, and a life member of Martha Washington Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star.

His first wife, Ethel Sanderson, to whom he was married 35 years, died in 1963.

Survivors include his wife, Avice, of North Vassalboro; one daughter, Esther Mae Smith of Winslow; one stepson, Merton D. Campbell of Winslow; two stepdaughters, Joscelyn A. Moody of Macedon, N.Y., and Margaret C. Crosby of Benton; three grandchildren; 11 step-grandchildren, and five great-grandchildren.

Retired Portland businessman Maurice L. Sandler, 69, died Sunday in a local hospital after a long illness.

Mr. Sandler founded the Biddeford Auto Parts Co. in 1935 and later purchased American Gear Co. of Portland and South Portland and the Motor Supply Co. of Lewiston and Auburn. He combined the stores in the 1960s under the name United Auto Parts Co.

In 1969, he sold the firm to Marsan Industries, of which he served as chairman until 1971, when Marsan was acquired by International Telephone and Telegraph

He was active in the Masonic Order and the Kora Shrine. He was a founder and director of the Temple Beth-El and director of the Jewish Federation and other civic and philanthropic organizations. During the last few years he devoted his time to volunteer work for local cancer research organizations and institutions.

He is survived by his wife, Dorothy Alman Sandler of Portland, and two sons, Michael R. of Weston, Mass., formerly of Portland, and Dr. S. Gerald of Jerusalem, Israel, and Washington D.C.

Mr. Sands was born April 13, 1890, at Amesbury, Mass., the son of Millbury H. and Harriet Barteau Sands. He attended schools there and was a graduate of Amesbury High School and a college of pharmacy.

He was a registered pharmacist in Maine, Massachusetts and New Hampshire. For many years he owned and operated a pharmacy in Newmarket, N.H.
