Wilton, June 17. — George Edward Sands, former superintendent of the Wilton Woolen Mill, shoe store owner, and for 12 years postmaster at Wilton, died Monday night.

Mr. Sands was born in Cambleford, Canada, April 25, 1878, the son of Lord and Harriet Sands. The family moved to Dover, N. H., when he was less than a year old. Fifteen years later they moved to East Wilton, where, in 1903, Mr. Sands married Grace Belle Bates.

Several years after he moved to Corinna where he was superintendent of the Corinna Manufacturing Company for eight years. Upon his return to Wilton he held a like position at the Wilton Woolen Mill. Following this he operated a shoestore in partnership with his brother, Frank. From 1924 to 1936 he was postmaster here.

He is survived by his widow; a brother, Frank, of Wilton; two sisters, Mrs. A. H. Farnum of East Wilton and Mrs. Emma Hamilton of Wilton; three children, Mrs. James Reed, Mrs. Rupert Benson and Walter Sands of Wilton, and eight grandchildren.

He was a member of Williamson Lodge, I. O. O. F.; the Wilson Lake Rebekah Lodge; the Masonic Lodge and Eastern Star in Corinna; and the Congregational Church of Wilton.

Funeral services were held from the late residence on Thursday afternoon. Burial was in East Wilton Cemetery.

Bingham, Nov. 19—Taps will be sounded Thursday for Henry Sands, 87, last surviving Civil War veteran in Northern Somerset County, who died today at the home of his son, Robie Sands, following a long illness.

Mr. Sands, at the time a young boy, ran away from home at the height of the haying season to answer Abraham Lincoln's last call for volunteers. He told a big whopper about his age, had stuffed his pockets with different things to bring his weight up to 96, and was soon a soldier in the old Ninth Maine Infantry. He participated in many battles.

He was a native of Canada, the family coming to Solon to reside when he was eight years old. Returning to this region after the war he later married Matilda Smith of Bingham. For some time they conducted sporting camps and subsequently went into the restaurant business here. He gave this up following his wife's death.

Mr. Sands was a member of the Masons, the Order of the Eastern Star, Odd Fellows and Rebekahs. The son and four grandchildren survive.

A military funeral will be provided Thursday by the American Legion Post.
