He was the oldest living past master of Temple Lodge, AF & AM. He was a former member of the Westbrook Rotary Club, the other Masonic groups and the Westbrook Congregational Church. A founder of the Maine Publicity Bureau, he served as its first manager for two years without pay. 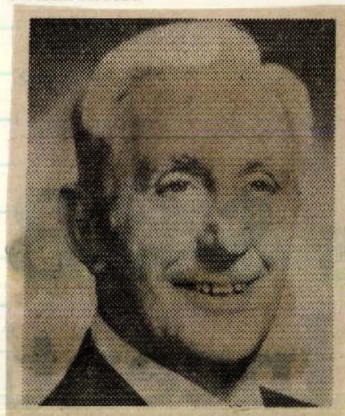

**FARMINGDALE** Robert L. Schoppe, 78, (past president) of the University of Maine Alumni Association and chairman of the Shrine Circus Committee, died Tuesday at his residence here.

As a member of the Kora Temple Shrine, Mr. Schoppe volunteered for years as a performing clown, entertain-

ing children at parades and in hospitals. A daughter, Sharon Wing, remembers that he called himself Curley.

"He just loved children. He loved to dress up and squeak his nose. He did it for quite a few years," Wing said.

He was born in Bozeman, Mont., a son of William and Marguerite Pillsbury Schoppe. His father was a professor of agriculture at the University of Montana. The family later returned to Maine where the elder Mr. Schoppe became

involved in poultry husbandry.

involved in poultry husbandry.

Mr. Schoppe attended Auburn schools. He graduated in 1934 from Edward Little High School, where he played football, and attended the University of Maine.

His daughter says that his time at the university made a deep impression on him and for the rest of his life he worked through the alumni association to make the experience available to others. "He just felt that education is very important, and that everything he did in his life was a result of his education."

He did not have the carefree life of an undergraduate, however, his daughter says. He worked numerous odd jobs to pay for his schooling and he married a fellow student, the former Mary "Midge" Flynn, in 1936.

In 1937 he was employed by Central Maine Power Co. as town and district manager in Norridgewock, Waldoboro and Bucksport. Wing says that she remembers as a very small child that he was often called into work during hurricanes and bad storms.

He served in the Navy during World War II, stationed on the West Coast. Following his service he returned to Auburn and served as treasurer and general manager of Motor Supply Co. of Lewiston from 1946 to 1953.

From 1953 to 1959, he was the general manager of Auburn Motor Sales. Mr. Schoppe owned and operated Schoppe Ford Sales in Augusta from 1959 to 1973. From 1973 until the time of his death, he was active in equipment sales, consulting, accounting services and real estate.

Wing says that although her father was a good businessman, he would sometimes make decisions that hurt him financially. "If there was someone in the mental health institute who couldn't get out unless he had a job, he would hire him. He would always give people the benefit of the doubt, he always gave a helping hand."
