South Portland, Jan. 17.—Capt. John G. Scott, 62, widely known merchant mariner and partner in the Scott Boat Yard, South Portland, died at his home, 77 Sawyer Street, today after an illness of five months.

Going to sea when he was but 14 years old, Captain Scott served several years on sailing vessels and rose through the ranks. He held a master's license more than 25 years and a pilot's license more than 15 years.

During nearly 30 years with the Standard Oil Company he was master on the Polerine, Delivery I and II, Portland Socony, Rockland Socony and Cape Ann Socony, and sailed on the New York Socony.

He was born at Deer Isle, Nov. 26, 1884, the son of Levi and Suzan Spinney Scott, who also were natives of Deer Isle. Before going to sea he attended school there.

He was a 32nd Degree Mason, a member of the Odd Fellows and the Knights of Pythias and honorary member of Hose Company I in South Portland.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Maude Card Scott; two daughters, Mrs. Corice J. Strout and Miss Donna L. Scott, both of South Portland; three sons, Winfield D., Levi J. and Maynard R. Scott, all of South Portland; a sister, Mrs. Ami Sewall of Rockland and a brother, Wallace Weed of Rockland.

NORTH LOVELL—Joseph M. Scott, 72, of North Lovell, died Saturday at the home of Joseph Moran, 1175 Broadway, South Portland.

Born in Moncton, N.B., Sept. 24, 1888, he was the son of James and Elizabeth Cail Scott.

CARIBOU — Ralph T. Scott, a prominent, well known Caribou businessman and civic leader, died in his 87th year at Caribou, May 26, 1983, after a long illness. He was born in North Head, Grand Manan, N.B., Can., Nov. 11, 1895, the son of George and Blanche (Thomas) Scott. He was educated in New Brunswick Schools and was a graduate of the Michigan Vocational School, Detroit, Mich. For many years he was one of the owners of Caribou Motor Co., the oldest Ford-Mercury dealership in New England. He was a veteran of World War I, having served in the U.S. Army Air Corps. He was a member of Gray Memorial United Methodist Church of Caribou and had served the church board of trustees.

He was a 32nd Degree Mason and a member of the Scottish Rite Bodies; a member and past master of Caribou Lodge No. 170; a past district deputy grand master of the Grand Lodge of Maine, AF & AM; a member and past high priest of Garfield Chapter No. 48, Royal Arch Masons, of Caribou; a pas-

grand high priest of the Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Maine. He was president of the Caribou Masonic Association having served as president since its inception in 1942. He was a member of the Caribou Rotary Club, Caribou and the Caribou Country Club. He was married to Violet (Shaw) Scott Oct. 5, 1921. Surviving besides his wife of Caribou are one son, Sheldon of Caribou; two grandchildren, Stephen Scott and Mrs. Steve (Shelley) Nadeau; four great-grandchildren, Michael Scott, Meghn Scott, Katherine Scott and Michelle Nadeau. INDIANAPOLIS — Robert Alvin Scott, 79, formerly of Freeport, Maine, died Aug. 19, 2001.

He was born in Boston, a son of James Joseph and Fanny Estelle Ireland Scott. He was raised on a small dairy farm in Freeport. He earned a B.A. degree from the University of Maine in 1950 and a master's degree from Cornell University in 1951. He was a Navy pilot during World War II.

He was retired as president of Maplehurst Dairy and Roberts Dairy. Mr. Scott was also the general manager of Borden's Dairy in Indianapolis in the 1960s and was appointed president of Borden's Midwest Dairy Division in Chicago.
