Waid, Deshon, Jalen and Marcus Sanders, and Whitney, Tanisha and Alivah Sanders: several nieces. nephews and grandnieces and grandnephews.

A funeral service for Fred C. Scribner Jr. will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday at the Cathedral Church of St. Luke, 143 State St.

Mr. Scribner, a prominent lawyer and longtime Republican national committeeman, died unexpectedly Wednesday in Portland. He was 86.

Mr. Scribner, who lived at 335 Foreside Road, Falmouth, was taken ill a short time before the funeral of his wife, the former Barbara Merrill, who died Dec. 30.

Born in Bath, son Fred C, and Emma Amelia Cheltra Scribner, he graduated from Deering High School in Portland in 1926, from Dartmouth College in 1930 and Harvard Law School in 1933. He joined a Portland law firm now known as Pierce, Atwood, Scribner, Allen, Smith & Lancaster and practiced there for 61 years - except for a period of government service and was active with the firm until the day of his death.

He served as general counsel for the Treasury Department from 1955-57 and was assistant treasury secretary in 1957 and undersecretary from 1957-61. Mr. Scribner received the department's Alexander Hamilton Award. He also was a member of the National Security Council from 1959-61.

In Washington, he was a founding partner with William J. Casey, former CIA chief, of Scribner, Hall &

Casey (now Scribner, Hall & Thompson.)

As a Republican, he was general counsel for the National Committee from 1955-61 and a member through 1970, and a member of the Falmouth Town Committee. He served as a delegate to four Republican National Conventions and traditionally moved their adjournments.

An Eagle Scout, Mr. Scribner was very active in Scouting throughout his life, including service on the National Council of Boy Scouts. He was a 33rd-degree Mason and a 60-year-plus member of the Kiwanis.

He had served as chancellor of the Episcopal Diocese of Maine for many years and was a member of Trinity

Episcopal Church of Portland.

Mr. Scriber served on the boards of many corporations in Maine and nationally and had been awarded honorary degrees by Dartmouth, Colby, Bowdoin and Bradford colleges, the universities of Maine and
