Walter V. Sellick boxer, steeplejack, builder

SCOTT PORTLAND - Walter V. Sellick, 67, of Broadway, a former boxer and owner of a construction company, died Monday at a Portland hospital.

He was born in Portland, a son of Leigh and Iva Welch Sellick, attended Portland High School where he was a graduate of Portland High School where he was a

gymnast and received a trophy for tumbling events.

Mr. Sellick graduated several years after his original classmates, said his wife, Norma E. Sellick, because he joined the Navy at the age of 17 and served in World War II aboard the USS Guadaloupe.

Mr. Sellick's mother agreed to sign papers allowing him to join the Navy at 17 only after he promised to return to school once he got out of the service. Mrs. Sellick said.

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

After returning to Portland after the war, Mr. Sellick completed school and became a semi-professional boxer, winning the Robert Ryan Boxing trophy in 1949.

He lost only one fight, Mrs. Sellick said, but gave up the sport shortly after he married her because she objected to it.

"I was really upset about it, and that's when he started being a steeplejack," she said. "I don't know which is worse."

Mr. Sellick had several close calls in that line of work, his wife said. One time, some bricks fell from the top of a smokestack and hit Mr. Sellick in the face, requiring stitches. Another time he was nearly blown off a stack in Massachusetts and hung by his arms

until he could manage to get down, she said.

One job that Mr. Sellick handled as a steeplejack was the restoration of the "Woodcock," a wooden Portland weathervane built in 1761. He removed and replaced all the dowels that held the oak components together, tediously took off the old finish and reapplied more than \$5,000 worth of gold leaf. The "Bird" was placed back on its perch on the First National Bank Building on Exchange Street in November 1963.

Mr. Sellick also worked as a licensed rugger. From 1948 through 1960, he worked for Chuck Construction Co. of Portland, and from 1960 through 1971 he and Bill Dauphinee owned Sellick Construction Co.

In 1971, Mr. Sellick went to work for Knowles Service Corp. of Westbrook. Three years later, he joined the Bulermaker's Union Local 29. He retired in 1994.

He recently took up leatherworking as a hobby. Mrs. Sellick said Mr. Sellick made leather belts, earnings cases for tape measures, harnesses and gun holsters.

This past Christmas, he made leather ornaments and sold them to members at the Portland Eagles Club, with the proceeds going to a children's facility at Maine Medical Center.

Mrs. Sellick said her husband was not particularly outgoing, but "if anyone needed a hand, he was always there to help. As my daughter just said tonight, 'If you got all the money back that people owed dad, you'd be a millionaire.'"

He was a member of Triangle Masonic Lodge, Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite Bodies, Kora Temple Shrine, Portland Eagles Club, Harold T. Andrews American Legion Post, South Portland VFW, Portland Armvets, Eagles Associates and Columbia Sports Club.

Survivors include his wife of 47 years, Norma E. Denbow Sellick of South Portland, a daughter, Bonny Jean Harvey of Biddeford, two sons, Richard B. Jr. of Portland and Walter S. of Lumbington, two brothers, Leigh W. Jr. of Portland and Gordon L. of Agawam, Mass., and four grandchildren.

Memorial services will be at 10 a.m. Thursday at Conroy-Tully South Portland Chapel, 1024 Broadway, South Portland. The Rev. Robert Cole of Bethel Christian Church will officiate.

Arthur Sewall, aged 74, former mayor of Bath and ex-president of the Bath National Bank, died this morning in a Boston hospital after an illness of several years.

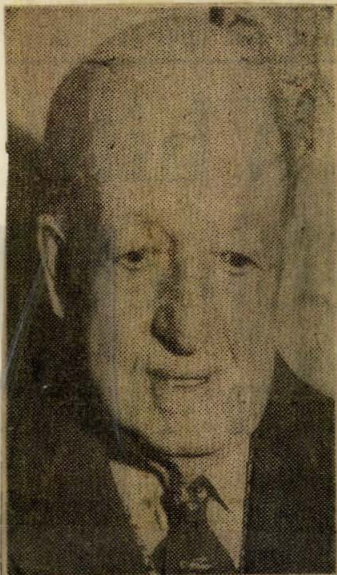
