CHINA - Arthur H. Sharpe, 96, of Route 32, South China, China's oldest resident, died Tuesday at a Waterville hospital.

He was born in Pembroke, New Brunswick, a son of Steven John and Annie Dickenson Sharpe, and served in the Second Canadian Division during World War I, where he was a sergeant major in France. He fought in the Battle of the Argonne and was decorated with a King's Corporal Medal.

He was an Aroostook potato farmer for a while after World War I and met his wife, the former Lois Marston, in Presque Isle while farming potatoes. "He had a knack for farming. He knew his soils well and could double the average yields given some time," said his adoptive son, Clinton Jenkins.

"He was successful until a couple of bad years came along. Crops were not good, prices were down and he lost most of what he had accumulated. He got away from the County with a team of horses, his wagon and his pride, and headed for Detroit to make cars," said Jenkins.

From 1925 to 1936, Mr. Sharpe was employed by Ford Motor Co. in a plant near Dearborn, Mich., which manufactured Model Ts and later Model As. In 1931, while the plant was making Model As he was a parts foreman on the midnight shift which had a crew of 3,500 workers.

He retired and sold his farm in 1974 at age 81 and then lived in a small home down the road.

Mr. Sharpe was a life member of Dirigo Lodge of Masons in Weeks Mills, and received a 50-year medal and veteran's medal from the Grand Lodge of Maine. He was a member of the South China Grange, and held the Boston Post gold-headed cane as China's oldest citizen.

Surviving are two sons, Clinton Jenkins of Yarmouth and Roland Jenkins of Columbus, Ohio, and a sister, Bernice Ebbett of Lexington, Mass.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday at Gray & Pratt Funeral Home, Windsor. The Rev. Winifred Reynolds will officiate. Burial will follow in Chadwick Hill Cemetery, South China. Members of Dirigo Lodge 104 will conduct a Masonic Memorial Service Saturday morning at the funeral home.

BENJAMIN SHAW.

After a lingering illness during the last three months of which he has been under treatment at the Maine General hospital, Benjamin Shaw, long one of the leading real estate agents of this city, died at that institution Monday afternoon. *April 11 1904.*
