WINDSOR — Lloyd F. Shaw, 78, of Windsor died Friday, Oct. 30, 1998, at Gray Birch Nursing Home in Augusta after a long and courageous battle with diabetes and cancer.

He was born in Greenville, the son of Hartwell and Fern Shaw. He attended school in Greenville and graduated from Mechanic Falls High School in 1939. On Nov. 1, 1942, he married Pauline Giddings of Mechanic Falls.

After a few years working in the restaurant business, he pursued a career with the Forest Service. He started as a watchman on a lookout tower for three years. He went on to Caratunk and Moscow as a patrolman and later to Union with four years of various activities in 22

towns. A promotion to District Ranger took him to Jefferson for several years. His last step in advancement was at the Bolton Hill Office as Regional Ranger. Over the years he spoke of his experiences to many clubs and organizations, some humorous and many serious. He was affectionately known to the younger generations as "Uncle Smokey" and as just plain "Smokey" to friends. He retired in 1982. For the past 10 years he had been a security guard at SCI Systems in Augusta; he retired from there in June of this year.

He was a past King Lion of Bingham Lions Club, past master several times of Seven Tree Grange in Union, and a member of Pioneer Grange in East Union. He was also a life-member of Knox County Fireman's Association, 32-year member and past master of Riverside Lodge in Jefferson, 32-year member of Lakeview Chapter No. 179 O.E.S. in Jefferson, where he was patron many times. He was honored to be a Grand Representative of Minnesota in Maine. He held honorary membership in Orient Chapter in Union, Arbutus Chapter in Liberty, Grace Chapter in Thomaston, Harbor Light Chapter in Rockport and Lily of the Valley Chapter in Weeks Mills. For many years his life was O.E.S. activities.

He was an avid sports fan but most of all enjoyed his camp in Greenville, where he loved the solitude and his animal friends.

He was predeceased by two sisters, Frances Dixon and Charlotte Frost.

Survivors include his wife of 56 years, Pauline Shaw of Windsor; sister, Louise Collins of Jacksonville, Fla.; several nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 7, at the Hall Funeral Home, 949 Main St., Waldoboro.


