Bridgton, Jan. 5. — Henry A. Shorey, jr., 74, weekly newspaper editor and publisher, the first chief of the Maine State Highway Police, and former deputy secretary of state, died suddenly today at Memorial Hospital here.

Death was attributed to a heart ailment.

Shorey, among the last of Maine's old-time country newspaper editors, was taken ill after supervising the make-up of the Thursday issue of his Bridgton News.

Shorey was born here Oct. 14, 1877, and except for his years in state service in Augusta, spent his entire life here.

He was the son of the late Major Henry A., and Ida Currier Shorey. His father founded the Bridgton News in 1870, and the son became its editor in 1923, carrying it on against spasmodic competition in the same homey, breezy and characteristic fashion as his father before him.

He was graduated from Bowdoin College in 1900. His first newspaper job was with the Bangor Commercial, covering the scattered towns of Old Town, Orono and Brewer.

Shorey gave up newspaper work for a time to hold several political jobs. He was deputy secretary of state under Frank W. Ball, and resigned that post to become chief organizer of the present State Highway Police and the first chief of the new system.

From 1923, when he took over the News from his father, Shorey stuck to Bridgton where he became a forceful protagonist for better roads, and a sharp observer of the political scene both from town matters to National.

In addition to his newspaper work here, Shorey served several terms as recorder of the Northern Cumberland Municipal Court.

A member of the Masonic Lodge here, Shorey also was a member of the Theta Delta Chi fraternity at Bowdoin.

Surviving are a son, Henry A. Shorey, 3rd, of Lexington, Mass., employed by a Boston book publishing firm; a daughter, Elizabeth Shorey, a school teacher at Southington, Conn.; and three sisters, Miss Eva L. Shorey and Mrs. Maude K. Walker, both of Bridgton, and Mrs. Harold A. Allan of Washington, D. C.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Tuesday at the First Congregational Church. Interment will be in High Street Cemetery.

SCARBOROUGH - Warren H. Shorey, 73, an active outdoorsman and historian, died unexpectedly Jan. 4 in Belhaven, N.C.

"From the time when he was a boy, working in the woods with his father logging, he always had a love of the outdoors and anything related to it," said Mr.

Shorey's daughter, Janet Tufts of Scarborough.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

In addition to hunting, fishing, snowmobiling and snowshoeing, Mr. Shorey also enjoyed guns and learned to make his own musket balls.

"He was quite a Civil War buff and always had been. His interest in the musket came from that. He hunted every year with shot and ball," his daughter said.

Mr. Shorey also was an accomplished carpenter, building the home he

lived in on Highland Avenue.

"I remember when we were little kids he built toy boxes and rocking chairs for our dollies. He built the house that my mom is in now. He cleared the lot, put down the cement blocks for the foundation, the whole thing," she said.

"He's done additions and porches. He's made boats, canoes ... he was very, very clever. He could figure anything out and if he couldn't figure it out he would read about it."

He also enjoyed reading and traveling.

"If it was a written word he would read it. He was particularly interested in history, but he would read anything," his daughter said.

Mr. Shorey worked as a truck driver for 28 years. He also worked as a carpenter, traveling to Juneau, Alaska, during the 1980s to do some carpentry work for the U.S. Coast Guard.

"You can imagine that is a sportsman's heaven up there,"

his daughter said.

Mr. Shorey was a member of the Masons, the VFW and the American Legion, all of Rangely. He was also a member of the Sportsman's Alliance of Maine.

Mr. Shorey served as a transportation sergeant with the Army during World War II and earned a Bronze Star.

"He never would tell us what he earned it for," Tufts said. "He was in the first division, they called it the Big Red One. They made a movie about it."

Mr. Shorey was born in Hollis, a son of Carlton and Ruby Whitten Shorey, and attended schools there.

He was predeceased by his brother, Carlton Jr., and his sister, Ruth Travers.

He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Elizabeth A. WILLIAM MOSES SHUBERT, M.D.

BANGOR — William M. Shubert, 78, died Nov. 26, 1994, after a long illness. He was born May 10, 1916, in Boston, Mass., the son of Rose and Julius Shubert, M.D. He was a graduate of the University of Iowa, Class of 1937, and Tufts College Medical School, Class of 1941. He interned at New Britain General Hospital, Conn., from 1941-1942. Dr. Shubert was a lieutenant colonel in the U.S. Army-Air Force from 1942-1946, serving as flight surgeon with the headquarters of the 99th Bomb Group. Dr. Shubert served as Chief of Obstetrics and Gynecology at St. Joseph Hospital and Chief of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Eastern Maine Medical Center from 1962-1980. In addition, Dr. Shubert served as a consultant to numerous area hospitals. During his long professional career, Dr. Shubert made many contributions to medicine. He patented a gynecological instrument, published several professional papers, and received numerous awards. His prime interest was maternal and child healthcare. He served as medical director of Penquis C.A.P. for more than a decade.

Dr. Shubert was a member of the St. Andrews Lodge No. 10 A.F. & A.M. and his membership in the VFW. Dr. Shubert served on the Bangor City Council from 1986-1989 and from 1992 to the present. In 1986, he received a blue ribbon in the "Beat the Squaw Mountain Man" ski race. Surviving in addition to his wife, Jane (Dunning) "Sandy" Shubert of Bangor are eight children, William M. Shubert Jr. and his wife, Carol, of Cherry Hill, N.J.; Jordan J. Shubert, M.D., and his wife, Phyllis, of Bangor; Susan A. Buchwald, M.D., and her husband, Theodore, of Reno, Nev.; Dennis L. Shubert, M.D., and his wife, Jane, of Bangor; Robert K. Shubert of Brewer; Alice S. Adams and her husband, Vernard, of Tampa, Fla.; Elizabeth V. Willette and her husband, Harold, of Seal Harbor; Jayson J. Shubert of Bangor. He was predeceased by a daughter, Sally M. Shubert. Also surviving are four stepchildren, Jane W. Garland of Hancock; Jonni-Anne Carlisle and her husband, Colin, of Halden; Joseph A. Garland of Dedham; James D. Garland of Bangor; 18 grandchildren, William M. III, Virginia and Alyson Shubert, Jennifer, Sarah, Daniel and Emily Shubert, Dana Buchwald, Kenyon, D. Zachary, Brooke and Christopher Shubert, Robert K. Sylvan Shurtleff

Sylvan Shurtleff, 55, member of a well known Portland family and himself long identified with the wholesale business in this City, died this morning at his summer home at Mineral Spring, Windham, following a brief illness. He suffered a heart attack a week ago at his summer place and this was given as the cause of death.

Born in Portland, son of the late William H. Shurtleff, Mr. Shurtleff, popularly known as "Syd," received his education in the Portland schools, including Portland High School, and at Hebron Academy. He then entered the employ of his father's firm, the W. H.
