John Albert Siegars

Funeral services were held Jan. 23 at Sanford for John Albert Siegars, 68, of Waterboro, who died suddenly at Alfred Monday, Jan. 20. Burial will be in the Spring at Bowdoinham Ridge Cemetery.

A native of Bowdoinham, Mr. Siegars was born Feb. 7, 1879, the son of Albert L. and Ella Sparks Siegars. He was graduated from Bowdoinham High School and Bates College. He had resided for the past 23 years in Waterboro, where he was owner and operator of Emery's Express. Before moving to Waterboro, he was teacher of piano and organ, having started with the late Lathan True, Buonamici and others.

Mr. Siegars had served as organist at the Alfred Congregational Church for the past ten years. He was organist at the Westbrook Congregational Church for three years, and at the Second Parish Church in Portland for 14 years. He was a member of the Kotzschmar Club and a colleague of the New England Chapter, American Guild of Organists.

Active in masonic orders, Mr. Siegars was a member of the Fraternal Lodge, AF&AM; Fern Chapter, OES; and a Royal Arch Mason of White Rose Chapter, Sanford, serving as organist for those bodies. He also was past commander of Beacon Commandery, Knights of Malta, Portland. He was a member of the Waterboro Grange and York County Pomona.

Besides his widow, Florence Woodbury Siegars, he is survived by a son, Albert W. Siegars of Falmouth Fore-

PORTLAND - Joseph D. Silverman, 93, of Portland, Pine Point and Boca Raton, Fla., died Saturday in the Maine Medical Center. He was born in Lynn, Mass., Jan. 28, 1910, a son of Hyman and Rachel Stone Silverman, graduating from Portland High School in 1930. Mr. Silverman was the founder of Century Tire Co., owning the company until selling to his son-in-law, Dick Aronson in 1976. He remained active until several years following his retirement. Mr. Silverman was one of the original members of Portland Boys & Girls Club, and was a member of the Portland Boys & Girls Club Alumni Association. He loved all children, even children he did not know, insisting they call him 'Papa Joe'. Joe, had a great love for life and took pride in helping customers who were starting in business and needed tires on long term credit. Mr. Silverman was a used car dealer for more than 40 years. He began in car sales during World War II,

running a small lot in Knightville in South Portland. Later he owned a lot in Portland on Forest Avenue. When the state took the lot to build Interstate 295, he moved his dealership to the corner of Bates and Veranda streets near the entrance to Tukey's Bridge. He retired 12 years ago.

Mr. Silverman also owned a gravel pit, and before and during World War II he ran Sam's Cafe on Commercial Street, as well as a night club in South Portland.

"He sold insurance when we got married," said Lillian Rapoport Silverman, his wife of 65 years. "Then he bought the concession stand at Willard Beach."

For many summers, the Silvermans ran the Willard Inn at the foot of Willard Street.

Mr. Silverman was an innovator at generating business, and he often ran special activities on the beach to attract a crowd. "He ran water races," said his wife. "He started a little zoo there, with a couple of cubs and some monkeys." He also organized baby carriage parades and gum chewing contests.

In 1935, the city of South Portland took him to court in an attempt to close down his Sunday bathing beauty contests. Under the state's old "blue laws," it was illegal to stage any kind of amateur competitive sport, and prosecutors attempted, unsuccessfully, to prove that Silverman's bathing beauty contest was competitive.

The jukebox on the porch of the Willard Inn was an attraction to neighborhood youths during the 1930s.

Mr. Silverman also ran popular beano games for the Willard Hose Co. at the inn. The games did so well that they financed the company's building on Pillsbury Street, according to his wife. After that he ran Saturday night beano games for various veterans groups.

Born in Portland, a son of William and Rebecca Druker Silverman, he graduated from Portland High School. He lived on Whitney Avenue for 33 years.

He was a member of Cedars Nursing Care Facility, the Brotherhood Lodge of Masons, and was a founder of Temple Beth El Brotherhood and Temple Beth El Memorial Park.
