Gardiner, Dec. 25 — Dr. Ralph Dumphy Simons, 61, member of the State Board of Registration for Medicine since 1929 and a former representative to the Legislature, died this noon in the Gardiner General Hospital after an illness of 10 days. He underwent an emergency operation Dec. 14 and a second operation Tuesday.

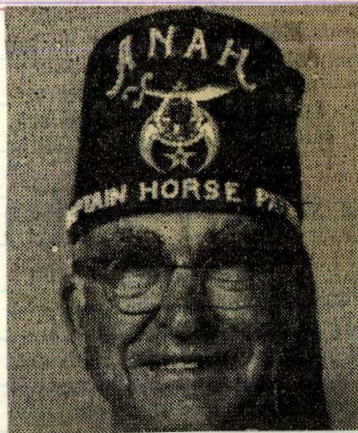

BRIDGTON — Edward Burleigh Simpson Jr., 78, who managed the former W.T. Grant store in Rockland, died July 25 at Northern Cumberland Memorial Hospital following a post-surgical cardiac arrest.

He was a son of Edward B. Simpson Mills and Grace March Simpson (later Richardson).

Mr. Simpson attended local schools, graduating in 1924 from Bridgton High School, where he was class salutatorian and a star forward on the basketball team. He also played clarinet and saxophone with Harry Cook's orchestra during this period.

He was a 1928 graduate of Bowdoin College. In 1931 he married Dorothy Jordan of Raymond, who was then teaching in Sanford.

Mr. Simpson went to New York immediately after graduation as a management trainee for W.T. Grant. He remained with Grant for his entire business career, working in Houston, Wichita Falls, Texas; Salt Lake City, Utah; East St. Louis, Ill.; South Bend, Ind.; Columbus, Ohio; Gary and Hammond, Ind., and Dayton, Ohio.

In 1962 Mr. Simpson returned to Maine and opened a new Grant outlet in Rockland. He retired in 1969.

In each of his career locations he was active in civic

activities, holding offices in several Chambers of Commerce and service clubs (notably Kiwanis), and working in local churches.

He also was active in Masonic and Shrine affairs, and became a 32nd degree Mason in the Scottish Rite.

Simpson was a member of the First Congregational Church here, served several years as treasurer of the Bridgton Historical Society, clerked at the polls for the Republican Party and sat on the board of Southern Maine Senior Citizens.

Simpson was a member of the local Conservation Commission. In that role he led a successful effort at a

Henry N. Simpson firefighter, safety officer

KENNEBUNK - Henry N. Simpson, 54, a well-known firefighter and safety officer for the Kennebunk Fire Department, died unexpectedly Tuesday at the Southern Maine Medical Center in Biddeford.

Mr. Simpson began volunteering with the Kennebunk Fire Department in 1977.

"He went to a field day one time and really liked it, and from that day on, he wanted to be on the fire department

- and he'd been a good member ever since,"

said Dick Roy, a long-time friend and deputy chief of the Kennebunk Fire Department. Mr. Simpson volunteered at the Washington Hose Company at Kennebunk Lower Village, serving as captain from 1977 through 1993. He then became the first safety officer for the Kennebunk Fire Department.

"He'd done a lot of things for the fire department, more than anybody will know," said

Roy. He said Mr. Simpson was often "helping people that had troubles, and he was there for everybody."

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

He was a member and past president of the York County Fireman's Association and a member of, and delegate to, the Maine State Federation of Firefighters. He was a member of the Pine Tree Burn Foundation and the York County Fire Chief's Association and was active in the York County Firefighters Training School. He was active and instrumental in the formation of Washington Hose Company, Search & Rescue Boat.

After retiring from the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard in 1993, Mr. Simpson worked as first mate on the scenic lobster boat Second Chance in Kennebunk. Roy said Mr. Simpson enjoyed his work on the boat because "he had a gift of gab."

Mr. Simpson made lobster buoys as a hobby. During Christmas Prelude, he would make buoys and donate half the money to the Fireman's Fund, Roy said.

Mr. Simpson was born in Boston, Mass., a son of Hugh and Mary St. Onge Simpson. He attended Woonsocket, R.I., schools. He served as a chief boatswain's mate the U.S. Coast Guard. Following his Coast Guard service, he enlisted in the Seabee's Reserve. He then enrolled in the apprentice program at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard in Kittery. He was a certified welder and later became safety officer at the shipyard.

Mr. Simpson was a member of York Lodge of Masons #22 of Kennebunk, the Scottish Rite Bodies, and the Maine Consistory Valley of Portland, Kora Shrine Temple of Lewiston, and the York County Shrine Club.

He is survived by his wife of 33 years, Sally Danforth Simpson, a son, Brian J. Simpson, and a granddaughter, Chloe Simpson, all of Kennebunk.

Visiting hours will be from 2 to 4 p.m. and 7 to 9 p.m. Thursday at the Bibber Memorial Chapel, 67 Summer St., Kennebunk, with a Masonic memorial service at 7:30 p.m. Thursday at the Chapel.
