— Ronald W. Simpson, 85, of Lewiston, and formerly of Sanford, died Wednesday at Central Maine Medical Center, Lewiston.

He was born Nov. 1, 1912 in Sanford, the son of Daniel and Mary Vennell Simpson, attended Sanford schools, and was a graduate of the University of Cincinnati, Ohio.

Mr. Simpson was a World War II Army veteran and was awarded the Purple Heart for wounds received in Germany.

He was employed as an accountant for Goodall Sanford Mills and the Adams Trucking Company, and as a controller for Tempstat, of Keene, N.H.

He was a member of the Grand Order of Masons, and attended services at the High Street Congregational Church in Auburn and the Sanford Baptist Church, Sanford.

FORT KENT -- John Glenroy Sinclair, 86, died Oct. 31, 2006, in Fort Kent. He was born in St. Francis on Sept. 7, 1920, the son of John Roy Sinclair and Delia Savage Sinclair. The fourth of nine children, John left school when he was 16 to work in the woods to help support his family during the Depression. He learned surveying from his father and joined the U. S. Corps of Engineers in 1940. When he joined the Navy after Pearl Harbor he was assigned to an aerial mapping unit and was involved with surveying in Greenland, South and Central America.

John married Mary Jane Baker of St. Francis in 1944, and after the war they moved to St. Pamphile where he became the District Manager of the Pingree Heirs and the Chief Fire Warden for the Seven Island District. In 1956, he moved his family to Bangor and became the Woodlands Manager for the Pingree Heirs. When the Seven Islands Land Company was formed in 1964, John became its first president and served until 1977, managing over a million acres of Maine timberland.

John's life is not reflected in his resume, but rather in his passion for the Maine woods and his love for the St. John River. In 1977, Colby College awarded John, who had no formal education beyond 10th grade, an honorary Doctor of Science. The citation accompanying the degree states:

Far beyond his technical mastery of forest principles and practice, he has recognized the ultimate values of the Maine woods, sought new techniques of cultivation and management, and developed markets here and abroad for Maine's most important renewable natural resource. Mr. Sinclair is the driving force behind the North Maine Woods, a unique association of public and private landowners...the largest recreational preserve of its kind in the world. He was responsible for initiating the Maine High Adventure Program of the Boy Scouts of America. A logger and woodsman, his speech is salted with their idiom, and when in a hundred years the Maine woods are still our greatest natural resource it will have been in large part the accomplishment of Mr. Sinclair.

## Henry J. Sinnett

banker, world's longest-serving Kiwanian

Henry J. Sinnett, 99, a retired bank president and investment banker who was the world's longest-serving member of Kiwanis International, died Sunday at a local hospital.

He lived nearly 50 years at 155 Pleasant Ave., Portland.

### PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Mr. Sinnett was a banker in Portland for 46 years before retiring in 1961 as president of the former Home Savings & Loan at 431 Congress St. He had been secretary and treasurer of Home S&L for many years, and was promoted to executive vice president in 1951, and president in 1959.

He began his career in 1915 with the former Casco Loan & Building Association, which had headquarters on Exchange Street, and was elected secretary

and treasurer of that bank in 1921. Casco was the predecessor of Home S&L, which later merged with the former Sun Savings & Loan.

Mr. Sinnett was honored in 1991 as the longest serving

Kiwanis Club member out of the 300,000 members worldwide. The volunteer service organization includes 8,000 local chapters that assist the aging, the young, the poor and communities in general. He joined the Portland Kiwanis Club in 1919, two years after the international organization was formed.

"Of course I appreciate it," Mr. Sinnett said in a Press Herald account of the award ceremony. "It comes a little late in the cycle.

"The fellowship was one thing," he said of his years in the Kiwanis. "And there was always the feeling that we were doing something good over the years."

After retiring from banking in 1961, Mr. Sinnett worked as an investment banker for the former Charles H. Gilman & Co., now H.M. Fayson, retiring in 1976.

Born on Bailey Island at Harpswell, a son of Everett and Eunice Bibber Sinnett, he attended schools on Bailey Island and graduated from Gray's Business College in Portland. He was an Army sergeant during World War I.

Mr. Sinnett was a former secretary and life member of the Portland Kiwanis, and received the Number 1 Certificate for Legion of Honor from Kiwanis International on his 70th and 75th year of service.

He received the club's Distinguished Service Award in 1991.

He was a past president of the Maine Savings and Loan League and a director for 10 years of the United States Savings and Loan League. He was a former director of Associated Charities in Portland, director of the Maine Humane Society and Boy Scouts of America, and a member of the Harold T. Andrews American Legion Post, the Masons and the Order of the Eastern Star.

A son, Peter J., died in 1936.

Surviving is a daughter, Joanna Sinnett of Portland. A funeral will be held at 3 p.m. Wednesday at Jones, Rich & Hutchins Funeral Home, 199 Woodford St. The Rev. Edward Fenderson will officiate. Burial will be private.
