Carroll B. Skillin, 68, local attorney and former president of the Maine State Chamber of Commerce, died Sunday in his home, 6 Deering Street, after a long illness.

Mr. Skillin for six years, until last July, had been confined to a wheel chair, but continued his office practice. Since that time he had carried on a limited practice from his home.

Mr. Skillin was head of the State Chamber of Commerce from 1939 to 1945 when he resigned because of ill health. He had been a practicing attorney here since 1909.

He also was chairman of the Republican City Committee here about 27 years ago.



He was born at Walnut Hill, North Yarmouth, Aug. 9, 1884, son of Sumner and Elizabeth Skillin. He attended schools of that town and was graduated from North Yarmouth Academy in 1904 and from the University of Maine Law School in 1908. After leaving school he practiced law for about a year in Augusta. He then came to Portland where he became a law partner of the late Thomas A. Sanders.

He was a 32nd Degree Mason, member of the Round Table, Ex-exutive Club and was a past treasurer of Korea Shrine Club of Portland. He also was a member of Wescustogo Grange and a trustee of North Yarmouth Academy. He

also was vice president of Blake-Rounds Supply Company here.

Mr. Skillin was married to the former Martha Wright of San Antonio, Tex., shortly after leaving college.

Besides his widow he leaves a son, Lt. Col. Byron W. Skillin, USAF, Washington, D. C.; a daughter, Mrs. B. William Holbrook, Portland; a brother, Isaac Skillin, Freeport, and a sister, Mrs. Mabel Kennedy of Portland and Florida.

A lifelong resident of Falmouth, John was born Jan. 13, 1930 in Dover, N.H., a son of Alexander and Florence Orson Skillin. He was a graduate of Falmouth High School and of the University of

Maine at Orono where he was a member of Phi Mu Delta Fraternity.

In 1962, John joined Skillin's Greenhouses succeeding his grandfather as President of the company. The florist and nursery business was started in 1885 by Alexander "Pa" Skillin and today continues as a thriving family business.

In 2000, John and his brother, Dave Skillin, were honored for lifetime industry achievement by the Maine Landscape and Nursery Association with the Al Black Award, honoring individuals who have had a significant impact on the Maine landscape and nursery industry.

John continued to be active in the company's wholesale tree operation, Mountainview Farm, where the nurturing of Christmas trees, shrubs, and evergreens continued the family tradition.

John had been a leader in his community. A fifty-year member of Casco Masonic Lodge and Kora Shrine, he was also on the board of the Cerebral Palsy Center and the Pine Grove Cemetery.

John loved hunting, fishing, and snowmobiling at his family's camps on Moosehead Lake. Together with woodworking, he was an avid antique auto renovator with a love for 1931 Chevy's. On summer mornings, you could see John and family motoring over the hills of southern Maine, often with a host of other antique auto buffs.

John's family always came first and most interests included the companionship of this close-knit group.

John is survived by his wife of 49 years, Sally Talbot Skillin; a daughter, Jill of East Orange, Vt.; two sons, Terrance and his wife, Erlene of Falmouth, and Jeffrey and his wife, Lisa of Falmouth; five grandchildren, Chad Skillin, Kristina Skillin, Cayla Skillin-Braucke, Jessica Skillin and Lee Skillin; a brother, David and his wife, Brenda; two nephews; and a niece.

## Henry A. Skillings

Henry A. Skillings, 67, an employee of the city 33 years and retired superintendent of City Hall, died suddenly of heart disease in a Portland hospital late Friday afternoon.

Mr. Skillings, who was known to his many friends and associates as "Bert," was stricken ill in his home, 496 Cottage Road, South Portland, where he had lived since 1944.

A Portland native, he was born Dec. 22, 1882, the son of George H. and Carrie Phillips Skillings. He attended public schools here and was graduated from Portland High School and Gray's Business College.

After his retirement from city employ in December, 1948, he was named agent of the Masonic Trustees of Masonic Temple.

Mr. Skillings began his long service with the city in February, 1913, when he was appointed chief engineer of the city building.
