A member of the fire department for 20 years, he became its chief in 1946, one year before the Bar Harbor fire. In that fire which destroyed onethird of the town and cost \$10 million damage and three lives, Chief Sleeper directed the efforts of upwards of 1,000 men.

Following the fire, he was instrumental in forming the Hancock Firemen's Association, composed of the county's fire departments which were coordinated in fire fighting with Steeper as head. He was also a director.

He was secretary-treasurer of the Maine Fire Chiefs Association, and a member of the New England and international associations.

Chief Sleeper was a member of the Masonic Lodge at Bar Harbor and Anah Temple Shrine of Bangor.
