department at 27, he followed

and James Black. Skillings was the
youngest officer of 39, who wore
the uniform when he reported
on April 1, 1877.

A man of his size and weight,
five feet eight and a half inches tall
and 180 pounds, Skillings' ability to
deal with the rougher element on his
beat in the Police Department legend.
His first beat was the Washington
area, after which he was
moved to the even tougher sec-
ond beat on Fore Street known in those
days as Sailor Town. He also cov-
ered Commercial Street and Gor-
don's corner. At no time was it ever
in the Police Department re-
garded that Patrolman Skillings ever
did his second best in an argu-
ment, rough and tumble.

During his 38 years of service, he
did at one time that he walked
100 miles, equivalent to seven
times the circumference of the world,

Surviving him are two other
daughters, Mrs. Frank P. Powers of
Portland and Mrs. Frank Peabbles of
Berkeley, California; a son, A. P.
Skillings of Peaks Island; seven
grandchildren and six great-grand-
children. His wife, Mary Currier
Skillings, died 12 years ago.

Westbrook, Dec. 30—Stephen H. Skillings, 96, oldest resident of this city and believed one of the oldest past masters in the Maine Masonic Lodge, died tonight in his home, 779 Main Street, after a long illness. A life-long resident of Westbrook, he was born Sept. 25, 1849, son of



Timothy and Rachel Hopkinson Skillings, and attended the local schools.

He operated a farm and dairy business on the old family homestead on Stroudwater Street for several years before his retirement over 40 years ago. As a boy, he carried milk from his father's farm to the Union soldier's encampment on the present site of Calvary Cemetery, South Portland. He tended the local lock in the old Cumberland-Oxford Canal that ran between Sebago Lake and Fore River one summer in his early boyhood. He was widely known as a small game hunter in his younger days and continued that sport until a few years ago. He also was an able craftsman.

Mr. Skillings was a past master of Temple Lodge, F. and A. M.; past high priest of Eagle Royal Arch Chapter, R. and S. M.; past noble grand of Saccarappa Lodge, IOOF, past worthy patron of Mizpah Chapter, OES, and a member of Westbrook Council. He joined Temple Lodge in 1890, and was active in lodge activities until two years ago. He formerly attended Westbrook Congregational Church.

Surviving are a niece, Mrs. Sally Munn of Tacoma, Wash.; and four nephews, Samuel F. Skillings of Tacoma and Frank Elwell and Harry F. Merrill of Portland.

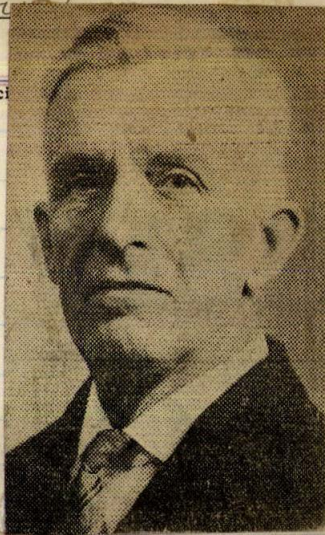

BAR HARBOR—Fire Chief David Albert Sleeper, 53, who coordinated efforts to halt the disastrous blaze which swept over Mount Desert Island in October 1947, died yesterday, his birthday, in a Bar Harbor hospital. He had undergone an operation last Friday.

A life long resident of this town, he was born Feb. 26, 1905, son of Bert L. and Susan Mosley Sleeper. He was educated in Bar Harbor Schools.
