FREEPORT — Kenneth C. "Spike" Sloat of Oak Leaf Terrace died unexpectedly Thursday at a Brunswick hospital.

SOUTH PORTLAND - George Clinton Slocum, 86, of Angell Terrace, South Portland, died Thursday at a Portland hospital. He was born in St. John, New Brunswick, Canada, a son of George W. and Marjory Ellen Williamson Slocum and attended schools in Canada. He graduated from Normal School at 18 and taught school in a one-room school house for several years in Waterborough, Canada, and Grand Manann Island.

He attended the University of New Brunswick in Fredricton, Canada, and received a degree in electrical engineering. He did graduate work at Gorham Teacher's College, Lincoln Electric Company, Hobart Technical School, Atomic Energy Facility at Oak Ridge, Tenn., and Penn State University. Mr. Slocum became a United States citizen in 1942. He taught aeronautics troubleshooting for the Army Air Force before enlisting in the Marine Corps, where he served in the Pacific Theater from 1943 to 1946.

He was an administrator for 11 years with the Civil Air Patrol with the rank of major. He was chairman of the Maine Chapter of American Welding Society for two years and treasurer for 20 years. He was a member of the Masons, Hiram Lodge in South Portland and a past member of the Portland Masonic Club, where he served as chairman for a year.

Mr. Slocum was one of the original instructors of Maine Vocational Technical Institute in Augusta, where it first originated. He taught from 1946 to 1982, when he retired from the Southern Maine Vocational Technical Institute in South Portland. He was a part-time instructor until 1989.

Surviving is his wife of 48 years, Frances Girard Slocum; two daughters, Carol Reid of Falmouth, and Helen Simondof of Jamaica Plain, Mass.; and a brother, Ronald of Arlington, Mass.

Visiting hours are from 2 to 4 p.m. Monday at Hobbs Funeral Home, 230 Cottage Road. A funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday in St. Peters Episcopal Church, 678 Washington Ave., Portland. Burial will be in Gracelawn Memorial Park, Auburn.
