Fred L. Small, 55, of Waterville died Sunday, Sept. 2, in a Waterville hospital following an illness of one week after an operation for acute pancreatitis.

Mr. Small was born at Abbot but lived at Sangerville during his childhood and youth. He married the former Miss Martha Hayden. For 18 years he was employed in the Sangerville Woolen Company mill and for a period of five years worked in the Indian Motorcycle shops in Springfield, Mass. Returning to Maine, he became owner and manager of the Piscataquis Steam Laundry at Dover-Foxcroft, a firm he operated for eight years. For two years, with Mrs. Small, he conducted a tea room at Newport and in more recent years had been employed in the office of the Health and Welfare Department, State House, Augusta.

GORHAM — Fred W. Small, 73, of Main St., local attorney, former trial justice and former town clerk more than 20 years, died yesterday in a Portland hospital after a long illness.

A Gorham resident since 1927, Mr. Small completed 22 years as town clerk in March, 1952, resigning at that time to devote more time to his law practice. He was also tax collector for the Village Corporation.

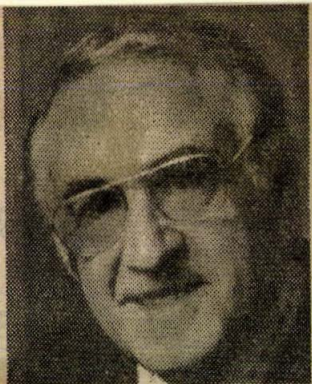
