Newcastle, Aug. 15. — Mrs. Arthur B. Smith, of North Newcastle is alive and unhurt today because she was quick with the brake when her husband collapsed and died at the wheel of their car this morning.

They were on their way to a doctor's, Mrs. Smith said. Smith had complained of illness.

He collapsed as he drove toward town along the Mills Road. Mrs. Smith said she didn't notice that until the car started wobbling across the road. It headed toward a utility pole. She steadied her unconscious husband and pushed against the brake pedal. The vehicle stopped a few feet from the pole.

Dr. Phillip Gregory of Boothbay Harbor said Smith died of coronary thrombosis.

He was a life-long resident of North Newcastle, born March 21, 1895, the son of Steward and Carrie Morgan Smith. He was a farmer and a member of the Damariscotta Mills Baptist Church, a Mason and past member of Bunker Hill Grange. He had been employed as a school bus driver.

Besides his widow, Edith Fairbrother Smith, he leaves four sons, Kenneth, USMC, stationed in California; Frank, Seward and Richard Smith, North Newcastle, and a sister, Mrs. Mary Sherman, Damariscotta.

Bangor, Aug. 29. (AP) — Dr. Ashley A. Smith, pastor emeritus of the First Universalist Church of this city, died today after a lingering illness.

Born in Auburn May 29, 1871, Doctor Smith was graduated in 1891 from Edward Little High School there and received the degree of bachelor of divinity from Crane Theological School, Tufts College, in 1895, and was ordained to the Universalist ministry the same year.

Bangor, Feb. 24. — Belmont A. Smith, 76, Bangor, resident of a local insurance firm and former state treasurer, died at a local hospital Friday following a brief illness.

He served three terms as state treasurer under the administrations of Governor Sumner Sewall and Lewis O. Barrows and was a state representative in the 87th Legislature.

One of his first political positions was on the executive council of Gov. Owen Brewster.

Born in Newburgh on April 2, 1874, he was the son of the late James and Jane Rogers Smith.

A graduate of Maine Central Institute, Pittsfield, he operated the Corinna Manufacturing Company during the early 1900's. The concern is now known as the Eastland Woolen Mills.
