He worked in the East Shipyard in Portland from 1941-1945, had worked as a clerk at Jackson's Market in Norway from 1945-1953, and operated a country store in Stoneham from 1953-1958. He was predeceased by two sisters, Lenora Herrick in 1989 and Dorothy Thayer in 1957; two brothers, Robert Smith in 1988 and Melvin (Cappy) Smith in 1979.
