Milton V. Smith, 70, of 45 Eastern Promenade, a pioneer aviator in Maine responsible for the state's early development of aviation service and a non-paid manager of the Portland airport for 20 years, died Sunday in a Portland hospital.

He was born in Portland, the son of Dr. Frederick M. Smith and Martha Vose Smith. He graduated from Portland High School and then went into flying service.

Mr. Smith was a pioneer aviator and soloed in 1928. He learned to fly from the Portland area's airport, which was a field in Scarborough off Route 1.
